RE: Public Notice: Summer Meal Waivers

MESSAGE:

The Pennsylvania Department of Education (PDE), Division of Food and Nutrition (DFN), has requested waivers from the following regulations for summer 2024.

Waivers related to excessive heat:

The waivers in this section apply to Summer Food Service Program (SFSP) and Seamless Summer Option (SSO) sponsors, in good standing, to operate approved outdoor meal sites without temperature-controlled alternative sites as non-congregate sites on days when the area is experiencing excessive heat for the period of May 1, 2024, through September 30, 2024.

- Non-Congregate Meal Service [42U.S.C. 753(b)(1)(A), 42U.S.C.1761(a)(1)(D), and 7 CFR 225.6(i)(15)]
- Parent/Guardian Meal Pickup 42 U.S.C.1761(f)(3), 7 CFR 225.2 (Meals), and 7 CFR 225.9(d)(7)]
- Meal Service Times [7 CFR 225.16(c)(1), (2), and (3)]

Waivers related to air quality advisories:

The waivers in this section apply to SFSP and SSO sponsors, in good standing, to operate approved outdoor meal sites without alternative indoor sites as non-congregate sites on days when the area is experiencing certain air quality advisories for the period of May 1, 2024, through September 30, 2024.

- Non-Congregate Meal Service [42U.S.C. 1753(b)(1)(A), 42U.S.C. 1761(a)(1)(D), and 7 CFR 225.6(i)(15)]
- Parent/Guardian Meal Pickup [42 U.S.C. 1761(f)(3), 7 CFR 225.2 (Meals), and 7 CFR 225.9(d)(7)]
- Meal Service Times [7 CFR 225.16(c)(1), (2), and (3)]

Offer Versus Serve:

The waiver in this section applies to SFSP sponsors, in good standing, to use SFSP offer versus serve meal service parameters by non-school food authority (SFA) sponsors on a case-by-case basis for the period of May 1, 2024, through September 30, 2024.

- Offer Versus Serve [42U.S.C. 1761(f)(7) and 7 CFR 225.16(f)(1)(ii)]

Waivers related to school closures:

The waivers in this section apply to SFSP and SSO when schools are closed and congregate meal service operations are limited due to natural disasters, unscheduled major building repairs, court orders relating to school safety or other issues, labor-management disputes, or, when approved by the State Agency, for a similar unanticipated cause. Upon approval, the waivers in this section will also replace any previously approved SFSP/SSO waivers allowing non-congregate meal service operations for school year 2023-2024 (with no virtual learning), granted to State Agencies through April 30, 2024. This applies when school buildings are closed during the instructional year and virtual classes are not offered. These waivers are effective through June 30, 2024.

- Non-Congregate Meal Service [42 U.S.C.1753(b)(1)(A), 42 U.S.C. 1761(a)(1)(D), and 7 CFR 225.6(i)(15)]
- Parent/Guardian Meal Pickup [42 U.S.C.1761(f)(3),7 CFR225.2 (Meals), and 7 CFR 225.9(d)(7)]
- Meal Service Times [7 CFR225.16(c)(1), (2), and (3)]
- Service of Meals at School Sites [42U.S.C.1761(c)(1) and7 CFR 225.6(h)(1)(iv)]

This is a required public notice that PDE, DFN submitted a request to USDA for a waiver to use an alternative approve to assess compliance with the aforementioned regulations and guidance and does not imply the waiver has been approved at this time. Detailed guidance and instructions will be provided to School Nutrition Program Sponsors if USDA approval is granted.
