Acting Secretary Ortega,

The purpose of this correspondence is to notify the Pennsylvania Department of Education of the upcoming curtailment of the Alternative Education for Disruptive Youth (AEDY) program for the 2021-2022 School Year at the Luzerne Intermediate Unit. The curtailment of the AEDY program was made necessary as a result of a significant decline in enrollment. The AEDY program currently has zero students enrolled.

Following the recommendation of the Executive Director and concurrence of the Board of Directors, the Luzerne Intermediate Unit Board approved the curtailment of the AEDY program at its regular monthly meeting on April 28, 2021. The Board Meeting minutes from the April 28th meeting were subsequently approved at the May 26, 2021 Board Meeting. Motion and approved minutes roll call are enclosed.

As a result, all 10 professional staff members have been notified that their jobs have been eliminated and that they will need to post into other positions within the organization. Ultimately, we likely need to furlough 5 – 6 professional employees as a result of the curtailment of educational programming.
