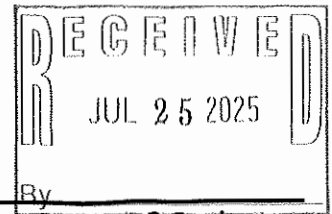

**IN RE: ARMSTRONG SCHOOL DISTRICT
 SECTION 1124(b) NOTIFICATION**

To Whom it May Concern:

Kindly consider this correspondence to be the notification required by Section 1124 of the Pennsylvania Public School Code, specifically Section 1124(b). As set forth in Section 1124(b), please be advised that the Armstrong School District has altered and curtailed its educational program.

The School District has altered and curtailed its educational program as set forth in Section 1124(a)(2) of the Pennsylvania Public School Code, as follows:

- The Elementary, Music, Physical Education, and Social Studies Programs shall be curtailed and altered by reducing the number of classes.
- The French Program shall be eliminated by no longer providing for any new enrollments in French. Students who have already commenced studying French will be permitted to continue through the fourth level. It should be noted that the District continues to offer Spanish and Mandarin.
- The Secondary Library Program shall no longer be provided. The secondary libraries shall remain accessible to individual students and/or classes receiving instruction in other subject areas.


This curtailment and alteration will be effective with the start of the 2025-26 school term.

As a result, five (5) professional employees (elementary, music physical education and library instructors) were suspended (furloughed) for the 2025-26 school term.

The suspensions also occurred as a result of substantial decrease in pupil enrollment, and a substantial decline in class and course enrollments within various programs.

RESOLUTION CURTAILING AND ALTERING PROGRAMS, AND SUSPENDING (FURLOUGHING) AND NOT RENEWING THE NECESSARY NUMBER OF TEACHERS

WHEREAS, there has been a substantial decrease in pupil enrollment in the Armstrong School District; and/or

WHEREAS, there has been a substantial decline in class and course enrollments within various programs; and/or

WHEREAS, in order to conform to standards of organization, the Superintendent has recommended that various programs be curtailed and altered; and/or

WHEREAS, in order to conform with educational activities, the Superintendent has recommended that various programs be curtailed and altered; and/or

WHEREAS, the Board of School Directors believes that the recommended changes will result in a more effective and efficient educational program; and

WHEREAS, the District is required to realign the professional staff pursuant to the Public School Code of 1949, as amended.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

1. Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent, the Elementary, Music, French, Library, Math, Physical Education, and Social Studies Programs shall be curtailed and altered by eliminating some courses, combining others, and/or reducing the number of classes.

2. Based upon evaluations, seniority and certifications, the following Professional Employees shall be suspended (furloughed) effective the start of the 2025-26 school term:

- 2.1. Shannon M. Jack
- 2.2. Pria A. Picardi
- 2.3. Kayla M. Karenbauer
- 2.4. Jeffrey M. Atwood.

3. Based upon seniority and certifications, the following Temporary Professional Employees shall not be renewed effective the start of the 2025-26 school term:

3.1. Megan E. Sulava

3.2. Nicole M. Martin

3.3. Stephanie L. Kasanicky

3.4. Madison D. Albright.

3.5. Ashley M. Potter shall be renewed, but for only a half-time position.

4. The Superintendent is directed and authorized to give appropriate notice to the Pennsylvania Department of Education.

5. The Superintendent shall give appropriate notice to the aforementioned employees pursuant to the applicable provisions of the Collective Bargaining Agreement, the Public School Code and the Local Agency Law, and take all of the steps necessary in connection therewith.

6. In the event required realignment would result in an employee being suspended (furloughed) or nonrenewed in lieu of one of the above stated employees, the Superintendent is hereby directed to give appropriate and timely notice to such alternate employee(s).
