# RULES AND REGULATIONS

Health Requirements	1. Health Requirements are listed in the <a href="#">General Rules and Regulations</a> . All entries will be subject to the <a href="#">General Rules and Regulations</a> .
Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza	<b>2. Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza is a deadly disease of many avian species and is a threat to Pennsylvania's poultry industry. Exhibition of avian species will be canceled if the venue is in a Control Area.</b>
Breed Classification Classes	<b>3. All breed classification classes will be open to YOUTH only (ages 8 to 18 as of January 1, 2026) for the 2026 show.</b>
Ownership	4. All poultry exhibited at the Pennsylvania Farm Show must be owned by the exhibitor and housed in Pennsylvania from the time entry is made until exhibited at the Farm Show.
Entry Limits	5. No more than TWO entries may be entered in one class by one exhibitor. <i>(For example, one exhibitor may not enter more than two White Rock cockerels).</i> NO SUBSTITUTION of entries may be made after closing date of entries.
<b>New!</b> Schedule	<p><b>6. <u>The avian showroom will be Exhibition C (Next to MacLay Street Lobby) open to receive avian (except Jr Market Turkeys) from 4:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. on Friday, January 9, 2026.</u></b> All exhibitors must be checked in by the PDA Health official by 8 p.m. Any birds NOT cooped by 8:00 p.m. will not be allowed in the show, NO exceptions. All birds will be strictly observed for general health at check-in. _</p> <p><b><u>Jr Market Turkeys will be housed in East Hall and will only be accepted Saturday, January 10, 2026 from 5:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. All turkeys will be removed Monday, January 12, 2026, 9:00 p.m. Turkeys that make the Jr Market Sale will be removed Tuesday, January 13, by 5:00 p.m.</u></b></p> <p><b>Birds showing any respiratory symptoms or signs of scaly leg, severely frozen combs or toes, or are extremely dirty or in poor feather condition will be denied entry into the show.</b> Birds should appear to be in good health and body condition for breed and/or age. The birds can be cooped only under the supervision of the Show Management.</p> <p><b>All birds (non Jr Market Turkeys) will be released on Saturday, January 17, 2026, at 5:00 p.m. and must be removed by 7:00 p.m. Birds must be cooped out under the supervision of Show Management.</b> All birds will be fed and watered daily during Farm Show. <b>An awards program and exhibitor meeting will be held in the show area at 3:00 p.m. on Saturday, January 17, 2026.</b></p>
Alterations	7. Management reserves the right to make any alterations that may seem desirable for the best interests of the show.
Judges	8. No person shall interfere with the judges in any manner while in the performance of their duties. Judges will be encouraged by the management to give exhibitors reasons for awarding a prize or for discriminating against a bird. Such information can be given after the judge has finished placing awards for a particular breed or variety.
Coops	9. No name and no distinctive marks or decorations will be allowed on the coops until after the premiums have been awarded. Any useful advertising material approved by the Show Manager may be placed on the cages after the awards are made.

# RULES AND REGULATIONS

Display Prizes	10. To compete for display prizes donated by the State Farm Show Commission, an exhibitor of standard chickens or bantams must exhibit at least seven individuals of one variety, including <b>AT LEAST ONE</b> cock, hen, cockerel, and pullet. All ties shall be broken by the subsequent decision of the judge.
Sale	11. <b>Sale of poultry is prohibited until after the birds have been cooped out by the exhibitor with supervision of Show Management or premiums will be forfeited.</b>
Award Points	12. All awards for display made by State Farm Show Commission will be decided in the following manner: First prize counts six points, second prize four points, third prize three points, fourth prize two points, fifth prize one point. Each prize to be multiplied by the number exhibited in the class. <i>(For example, first-prize Silver Wyandotte cockerel with 15 in class counts 90 points).</i>

New! Code of Show Ring Ethics	14. The <a href="#">Mandatory Code of Show Ring Ethics form</a> must be read, signed, dated, and then uploaded with entry by the entry deadline.

**Bantams** - Classes will be provided for all varieties listed in the Premium List for cock, hen, cockerel, and pullet.

**Turkeys** - Classes will be provided for all varieties listed in the Premium List for old tom, old hen, young tom, and young hen.

**Guineas** - Classes will be provided for all varieties listed in the Premium List for cock, hen, cockerel, and pullet.

## Eligibility

1. These classes are open to 4-H Club and FFA members. **Exhibitors must have been born in 2006 to 2016 inclusively.** Farm Show animals must be carried as a project under the supervision of the Pennsylvania State University Agricultural Extension Service or of a Pennsylvania Agricultural Education Instructor. 4-H Market Animal entries are a continuation of the previous 4-H year. During the previous year, 4-H members must have been enrolled with a poultry project and must be a member in good standing as defined by the state 4-H or FFA office. The Pennsylvania Farm Show is requiring all youth market livestock exhibitors showing at the Pennsylvania Farm Show to have completed the applicable **YQCA (Youth for the Quality Care of Animals) program training.** Proof of completion must be submitted to the Farm Show Livestock Office no later than your entry deadline date. Submit to [farmshow@pa.gov](mailto:farmshow@pa.gov) or submit with online entry. Unethical or abusive activities are not allowed and will result in disqualification of the exhibitor from the show at sole decision of Farm Show Management. (Read "Guidelines for Care of Animals" and the "Pennsylvania Farm Show Code of Show Ring Ethics"). The purpose of a youth project is to learn by doing via hands-on educational experiences. Youth who rely on professional fitters to perform activities in preparing their animals for show fail to gain these experiences.

## Exhibitor Responsibility

2. **It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to see that their animal is present at the specified time and place for weighing, showing, and selling.**

## Health Requirements

3. All entries will be subject to the General Rules and Regulations. **Exhibitors must present a copy of required testing results and the Owner Endorsed Avian Health Certificate and Biosecurity Statement at time of arrival.**

## Obtaining Turkeys

# FIRE REGULATIONS

1. All exit corridors and emergency exits must be kept clear; no partial blocking will be permitted.
2. All fire alarm pull stations must be kept clear.
3. Fire extinguishers may not be covered by any drapes or hidden by any type of displays.
4. No motorized camping units or vehicles may contain more than one (1) gallon of fuel while on display.
5. All pressurized fuel tanks may be drained.
6. All fuel fills must be locked and fuel caps must be taped closed with duct tape.
7. Any living trees and shrubs are acceptable as long as the shrubbery is individually bagged and baled.
8. Artificial trees and shrubbery must be treated with a flame proofing material. The fire official may request certification of flame proofing.
9. Any type of mulch materials must be treated with a flame proofing material or watered daily. If treated with a flame proofing material, certification may be requested by the fire official.
10. Smoking is prohibited in the Pennsylvania Farm Show Complex & Expo Center.
11. No open flames, fires or burning of any kind will be permitted within the Complex. No exterior burning is allowed unless the Department of Environmental Protection and the Bureau of Fire grant permission.
12. Vendors setting up tents, canopies and membrane covering must provide fire department with fire rating of material. Vendors must also provide any required portable fire extinguishers as needed.
13. Outside propane tanks shall be protected by posts or other approved physical barriers (Jersey barriers).
14. Extinguishers need to be visible, accessible and located in a conspicuous location where they will be readily accessible and immediately available for uses. These locations shall be along normal paths of travel.
15. Doors shall never be blocked or tied off.
16. The Fire Prevention Code of Harrisburg will be strictly enforced.

## EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS TIPS

### EARLY DETECTION

- Early detection is the most effective way to prevent emergencies or lessen their impacts.
- Vendors and exhibitors will likely be the first to witness, experience, or report incidents.
- You can be the difference in preventing something harmful from happening.
- To report any type of threat or emergency incident, notify the PA State Police Command Post.

### BOMB THREATS

- Threats can be made in person, by phone, or in written message.
- Collect as much detailed information as possible about the threat (when, why, how, exact wording of threat, type of voice, personal appearance, clothing description, name, gender, phone number, physical address).
- It is especially important to know the perpetrator's timeline for activation of the device (when will it occur?).
- Immediately report the threat to the State Police Command Post.
- Authorities will investigate the threat and make the proper decisions accordingly in coordination with facility management.

### LOST CHILDREN

- Be sure to get the full name of the lost child and keep them safe with you. Notify the Farm Show security desk or closest security/law enforcement team. PSP or Farm Show staff will help to reunite lost children with loved ones.

### SHELTER IN PLACE

- Although rare, there could be incidents that occur outside the facility that could put people at risk (chemical fire, very severe weather). In these instances, a shelter-in-place plan will be implemented for the welfare of all occupants.

### SUSPICIOUS OBJECT

- Do not touch or disturb the object.
- Maintain a safe distance from the object and attempt to isolate the area.
- Notify the State Police Command Post with a description and location of the object.

### SUSPICIOUS PERSON

- Observe the circumstances and behavior of the suspicious activity.
- Notify the State Police Command Post and provide as much detail as possible.
- Details about the person should include direction of travel, appearance, height and weight, build, clothing, speech, and anything about the behavior that indicates suspicion.

## FLOODING

- Facility management will attempt to mitigate the effects of flooding and natural disasters before they happen and will work with all show vendors during this type of event.
- The Maclay and West parking lots are susceptible to flash flooding.
- Avoid contact with flood water.
- If major interstates or surrounding roads are being closed, facility management will make announcements accordingly.

## MEDICAL EMERGENCY

- Notify the State Police Command Post and they will dispatch emergency medical services to the location.
- Describe the nature and severity of the medical incident and location of the victim.
- Do not attempt to move the person unless you are a trained medical responder.
- Stay with the victim and seek help from others if necessary.
- If rendering aid due to your training, be careful not to expose yourself to hazards such as fire, electricity, hazardous materials, or blood borne pathogens

## FIRE & EVACUATION

- If you see a fire, activate the nearest alarm or notify the Farm Show Security Desk.
- The City of Harrisburg Bureau of Fire will respond to the alarm.
- When the building evacuation alarm is activated, leave by the closest and safest exit and alert others to do the same.
- Quickly take all personal belongings.
- Please listen to the instructions of the PA system announcements, Farm Show Complex employees, or responders.
- Do not use elevators!
- The facility is equipped with sprinklers and ABC fire extinguishers.
- Once outside, move a safe distance from the building.
- Do not return to an evacuated building until the 'all-clear' sign is provided by the Fire Chief, a Police Officer, or any other official first responder.
- Do not operate cell phones during an evacuation until the 'all-clear' is given

- Your safety comes first. Use your best judgement to preserve your life.
- Report any physical abuse to the State Police Command Post.
- If there's an active shooter in the facility but not in your area, evacuate the facility and find safety.
- If the active shooter is near your area and preventing your escape, go to a room that can be lock or barricaded or hide and remain silent.
- If the shooter knows you are there but you feel you can flee, quickly evacuate the area.
- If you feel like fleeing is not possible, you can either confront, or attempt to overpower the person.
- If there is a shooter, messages regarding the known location of that person may be broadcast over the PA System.
