What you should know:

COVID-19 infection in pregnancy *increases* risk for *ICU admission at delivery*, preterm birth, and other adverse outcomes

COVID-19 vaccination is recommended if you are pregnant, breastfeeding, or planning to become pregnant.

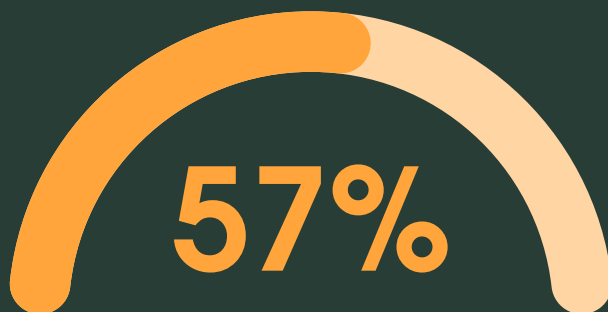
Vaccination still remains low, with significant differences in vaccine uptake by race, education, age, and socioeconomic status

VACCINE UPTAKE

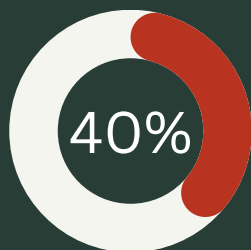
What You Should Know:

Approximately **57%** of persons with COVID-19 in pregnancy received the COVID-19 vaccine.

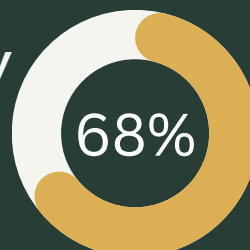


Percent of Individuals Receiving the COVID-19 Vaccine:

40% of those with Medicaid at delivery compared to **68%** of those with private insurance

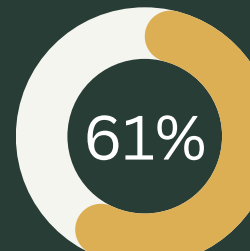


Private Insurance

Rural

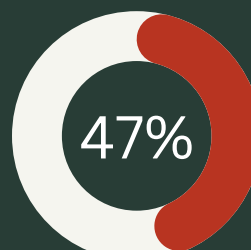


50% of those residing in rural areas compared to **61%** of those residing in urban areas

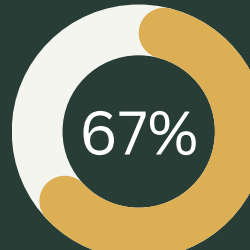


Urban
