## Preventing ticks on your pets.

Any animal can carry ticks, especially if they come in contact with grasses, brush, or wooded areas, including landscaped areas.

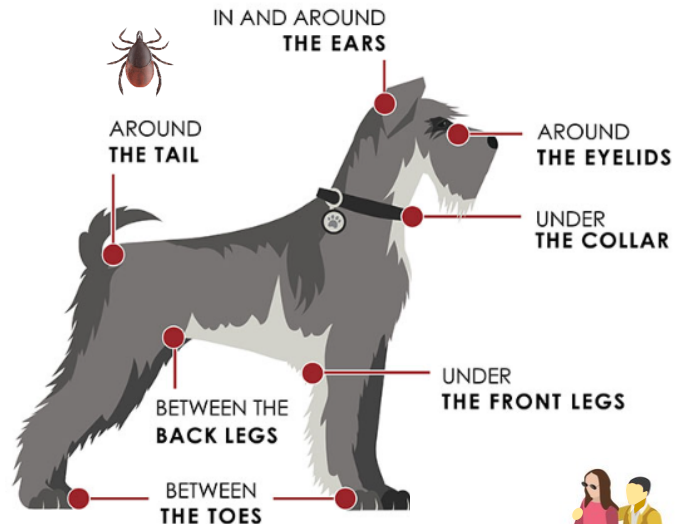
### Talk to your veterinarian about:

The best tick prevention products for your pets and tickborne diseases that are common in your area.

### To further reduce the chances that a tick bite will make your pets

- **Check your pets** for ticks daily, especially after they spend time outdoors.
- If you find a tick on your pet, **remove it** right away.
- Reduce **tick habitat** in your yard.

### Check everywhere on your pets for ticks, especially:



**Note:** Cats are extremely sensitive to a variety of chemicals. Do not apply any tick prevention products to your cats without first asking your veterinarian.
