

Key Points

- VFC Providers must submit their completed 2026 VFC Reenrollment template in PIERS by May 31, 2026.
- Disregard this notice if you already have an approved 2026 VFC Reenrollment template in PIERS.

Dear VFC Provider,

We are already halfway through the 2026 Reenrollment period, which closes on May 31, 2026. All VFC providers who enrolled before January 1, 2026, must submit their completed 2026 VFC Reenrollment template in PIERS by the deadline of May 31, 2026.

Please be aware for your planning purposes that if you need to make any updates to your clinic staff or your storage units, those update requests must be reviewed and approved by BOI staff, which can take up to three days. Those changes will not appear in your 2026 VFC Reenrollment template until they are approved.

If you already have an approved 2026 VFC Reenrollment template, no further action is needed. This notice is going out to all providers. Please disregard if you already have an approved template in PIERS.

You can check the status of your 2026 VFC Reenrollment template in PIERS any time you want. Please follow the instructions in the Checking the Status of Your Template section of the 2026 VFC Reenrollment Guide to check your status. Helpful Tips for Completing Reenrollment:

- You will need to upload the **2026** You Call the Shots Modules 10 and 16 certificates or the statements of completion for the VFC and Storage and Handling refresher tests for both the primary and backup coordinators.
- You will need to make sure your vaccine storage units have been added along with your DDLs/thermometers for your storage units and assign them to your storage units, your current, unexpired certificates of calibration for your DDLs, and your backup DDL with current certificate of calibration to PIERS.
