Phase 2: Eliminating the Background Check Fee for Eligible Caregivers

- **What is MMAP Phase 2?**
 - Phase 2 of the MMAP eliminates the background check fee (the cost associated with getting fingerprinted) for eligible caregivers.
- **Who is eligible to have their background check fees eliminated?**
 - Caregivers who have not been previously approved as a caregiver in the medical marijuana program are eligible. Only new, or first-time, caregivers are required to obtain a background check.
- **How will I get my caregiver background check fees eliminated?**
 - You will not be charged a fee for the service when you visit the IdentoGo site to be fingerprinted for a background check.
- **I know there are three phases to the implementation of the MMAP. If my caregiver background check fees are eliminated, will I be able to participate in the other phases of the MMAP?**
 - Yes. Elimination of the caregiver background fee will not impact your ability to participate in any other phases of the MMAP.
- **When will the elimination of the caregiver background check fees be implemented?**
 - Phase 2 has been implemented as of March 1, 2022.
