Miller, in her official capacity as Insurance Commissioner of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and her predecessor in office, are now discharged as Statutory Liquidator of Commonwealth Insurance Company (in Liquidation) and are released from any liability to make payment of any further claims.
