5. Nomination must be endorsed by the chief, assigned juvenile probation officer, or service provider. Nomination must be postmarked no later than **July 27, 2026**.
6. Nominee must show a reasonable positive adjustment and must continue to display positive behavior pending receipt of the award.
7. Nomination **MUST** be fully completed by a service provider, juvenile probation staff, or a juvenile court judge, **NOT** by the youth.

Nominations which do not meet all criteria will be rejected from the judging process.
