In an effort to provide our consumers and stakeholders valuable insight into our business, the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board is proud to present the 2011-2012 Retail Year in Review, our latest in-depth analysis of the agency's marketing and sales data. As you peruse this report, you will find detailed product sales information broken down by dollars and units, as well as by region, county and store to illustrate consumer tastes, product trends and opportunities for growth in Pennsylvania.

While the economy slowly improved in 2011-2012, sales at our stores grew significantly, reaching levels never seen before. Overall sales increased more than 6.7 percent compared to retail year (RY) 10 -11. We're proud of that growth because we believe it's a positive reflection of our focus on customer service and improving the consumers' experience.

In RY 11-12, spirits made up nearly 59 percent of total dollar sales statewide. By all measures, the most popular category continues to be vodka, making up more than 13 percent of all dollar sales at PA Wine & Spirits Stores. Several categories saw significant growth, including flavored vodkas and flavored whiskies.

While spirits made up the majority of our sales, wine did slightly improve its market share in RY 11-12 based on units sold. The most popular categories once again included chardonnay, cabernet and boxed wine. Illustrating that cost does matter when making purchasing decisions, the majority of wine consumers focused on domestic value-priced products.

As we begin RY 12-13, we assure you our commitment to our consumers will continue to be the focus of our efforts. Some of the initiatives underway include a rebranding of all of our stores to provide a world-class shopping experience for our consumers, continued data analysis to ensure we're providing the products consumers want and a renewed push to improve efficiencies within the agency to ultimately benefit the taxpayers of Pennsylvania.

The third edition of the Retail Year in Review (2011 – 2012) once again, seeks to present a user-friendly, approachable and educational view of the retail business of the PA Wine & Spirits Stores. This report has been shaped, over time, by reports from control states, the beverage alcohol industry and feedback from experts. Data was collected through the point of sales system (POS), stored in the data warehouse and extracted through Oracle BI.

A number of filters were used to pull data. Report filters include the retail year end date of 7/1/2012. Due to the leap year, the current year has 53 weeks of sales. Special orders (SO) are not included in all reports. Gregorian calendars, beginning on the first of the month and ending on the final day of the calendar month, were used for certain reports to eliminate any inconsistencies of the “four-five-four” week retail calendar. Each analysis section contains specific details on filters.

Through the process of continual data management there have been changes to data structures and collation procedures. This has an impact on certain part of the data. Brand changes due to updates to items, additions and holiday codes, may create different totals between year to year reports. Therefore, the brand section contains four instances with different totals than previously published.

The Retail Year in Review is a compilation of reports and only a few calculations were performed for comparison purposes. The two calculations are year-to-year change and percentage share. Year-to-year change measures the increase or decrease in transactions, units or dollars between retail years. Percentage share calculates how much a category or county contributes to an overall total. Dollar sales amounts do include the standard mark up and the emergency tax. Sales tax (6%) is not included in the dollar sales amounts. Local taxes for Allegheny and Philadelphia are also not applied.

Please note the data in this report are unaudited and may vary from financial statements. The data may also vary from other beverage alcohol industry reports due to calendar date alignments, sorting techniques and filter criteria as well as data normalization. Further, within the past year a new point of sales system (POS) has been implemented. This can create differences in how data are compiled, processed and stored in the data warehouse. Through the process of continual data management there have been changes to data structures and collation procedures. This has an impact on certain pieces of data such as brand and price segment.



RETAIL YEAR SALES & SHARES

Retail year sales and shares provide an overview of dollars, units and transactions within the commonwealth. Over the past six years, there has been a steady increase in total sales for the PA Wine & Spirits Stores. Dollar sales for the end of the current retail year, on regular and luxury items, were \$1,898,161,385. This represents a 6.76% increase from the previous year. Figure 1 summarizes the gains over the previous years. Please note, retail and licensee sales are included in this figure and special orders (SO) are not.

More specifically, there was a difference between the amount of wines and spirits sold. Table 1 illustrates that RY 2011 - 12 had a higher proportion of dollar sales for spirits or +17.94 points more than wine. The dollar shares of wine remained stable this year, despite a recent trend of gaining share.

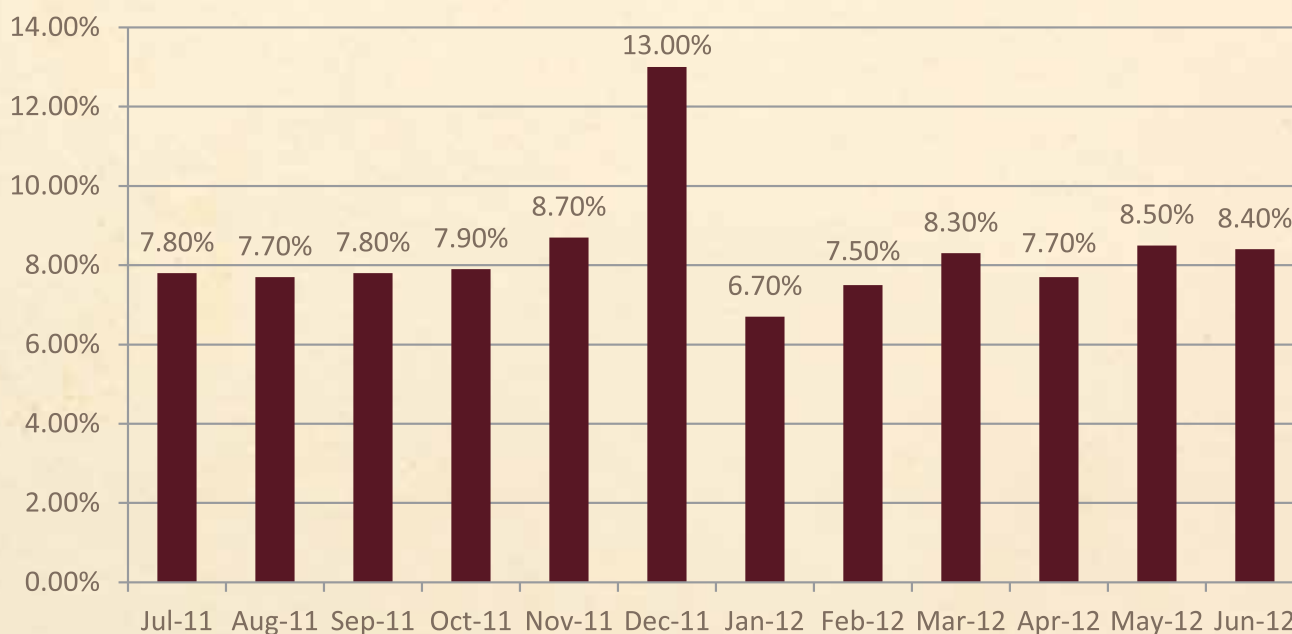
Table 2 shows that wines continued to slightly gain in unit share (+0.11).

An examination of sales by month helped to show the most active sales months¹. December (13.00%) and November (8.70%) tended to have the highest percentage of sales. In terms of dollars, December accounted for \$244,819,530 and November \$162,626,862. Outside of these months, May (8.50%, \$158,871,380) and June (8.40%, \$158,531,458) were the top performing months.

RETAIL YEAR SALES & SHARES

The top market categories are ranked by dollar sales in Table 3 . Vodka (\$253,371,888) and Vodka - Flavored (\$110,268,751) were the two largest categories for the retail year. In terms of growth, several categories, not listed here, dramatically increased because they were new, rapidly growing categories or added items. US Red - Sweet (168.96%), Wine Cooler (126.31%), US White - Moscato (88.33%) and Flavored Whiskey (68.51%) were the market categories with the highest percentage change from the previous year.

Dollar share is determined by the percentage of dollar sales a market category contributes to all sales. Table 4 ranks market categories based on the amount of share for retail year 2011 - 2012³. Vodka (13.35%), Vodka - Flavored (5.81%), Bourbon (5.26%), Shooters - Schnapps/Liqueurs (3.61%) and Rum - Spiced (3.53%) are the top 5 categories in terms of share. Vodka - Flavored (+0.61%), Flavored Whiskey (+0.28%), US White - Moscato (+0.25%) and US Red - Blends (+0.22%) gained the most share over last retail year.

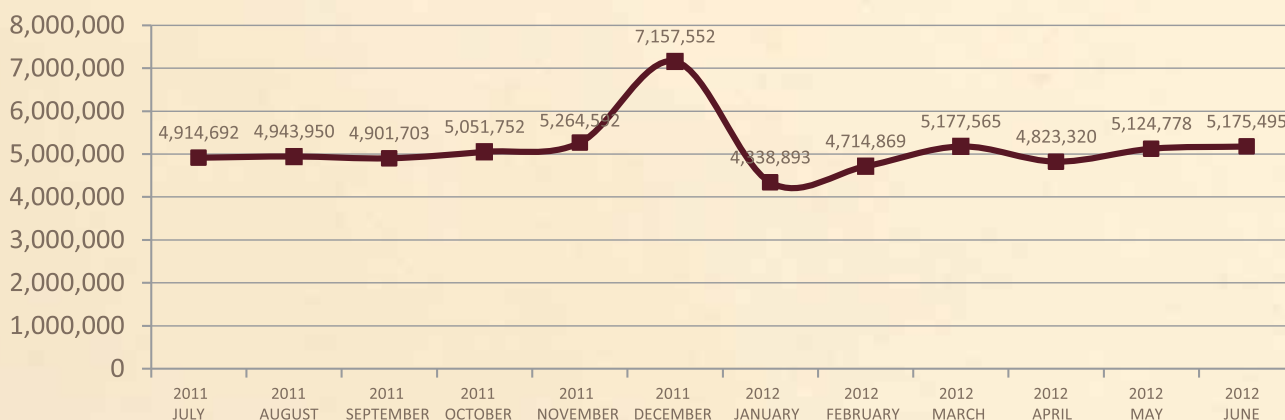

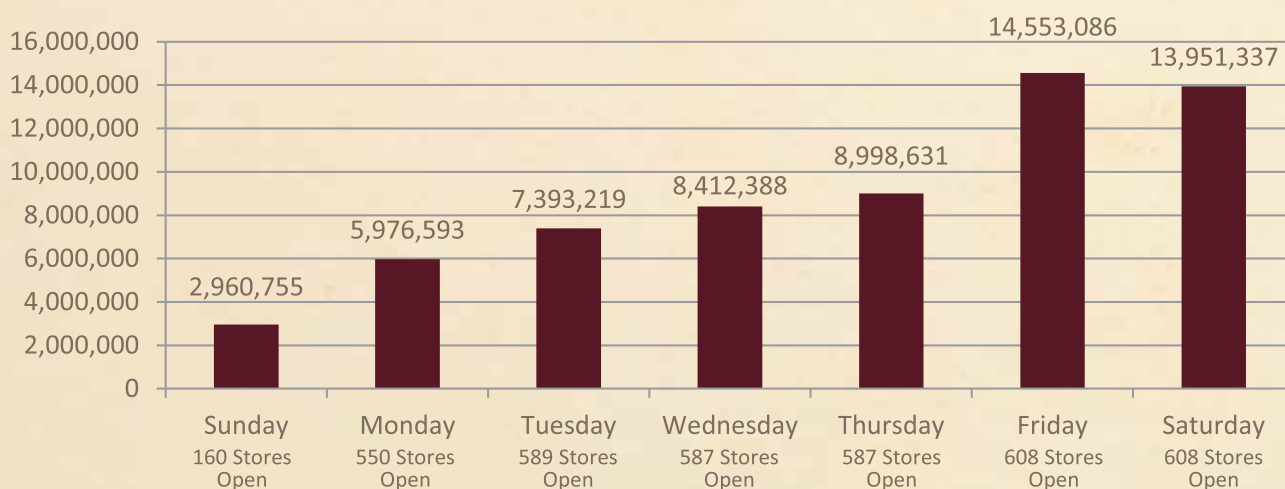
Monthly transaction counts are illustrated in Figure 3⁴. Similar to the percent of sales by month, December (7,157,552) and November (5,264,592) had the most transactions. The third most transactions occurred in March (5,177,565). For the entire calendar year there were 61,589,161 transactions.

Friday (14,553,086) and Saturday (13,951,337) were the busiest days of the week in the past retail year. Figure 4 graphs the days according to the amount of transactions⁵.

STORE & COUNTY REPORTS

This section, of county and store reports, shows the differences by county, in terms of their proportion of category sales and their proportion of sales. Performance of individual sales is also presented.

At the county level, categories had different dollar sales amounts and proportions⁶. Overall, Allegheny (\$243,529,821), Philadelphia (\$218,749,412) and Montgomery (\$184,300,452) counties had the highest dollar sales amounts. These counties also had the highest sales among each category. This is illustrated in Table 5⁷.

There is more detail when examining each county and the proportion of sales each category comprised. Figure 5 is a visual representation of the data. Table wines were more prevalent in the eastern part of the state. Proportionately, Chester (45.57%), Montgomery (44.76%) and Bucks (42.39%) counties had the most sales of Table Wine. Vodka was sold in greatest proportion in Philadelphia (23.16%), plus two western counties, Lawrence (22.60%) and Beaver (22.42%).

Rural counties trended towards Whiskey as Greene (31.22%), Forest (29.38%) and Sullivan (24.30%) had the highest proportion of sales. Rum sold proportionately higher in the middle of the state with Northumberland (17.28%), Mifflin (17.02%) and Perry (16.41%) counties ranking highest.



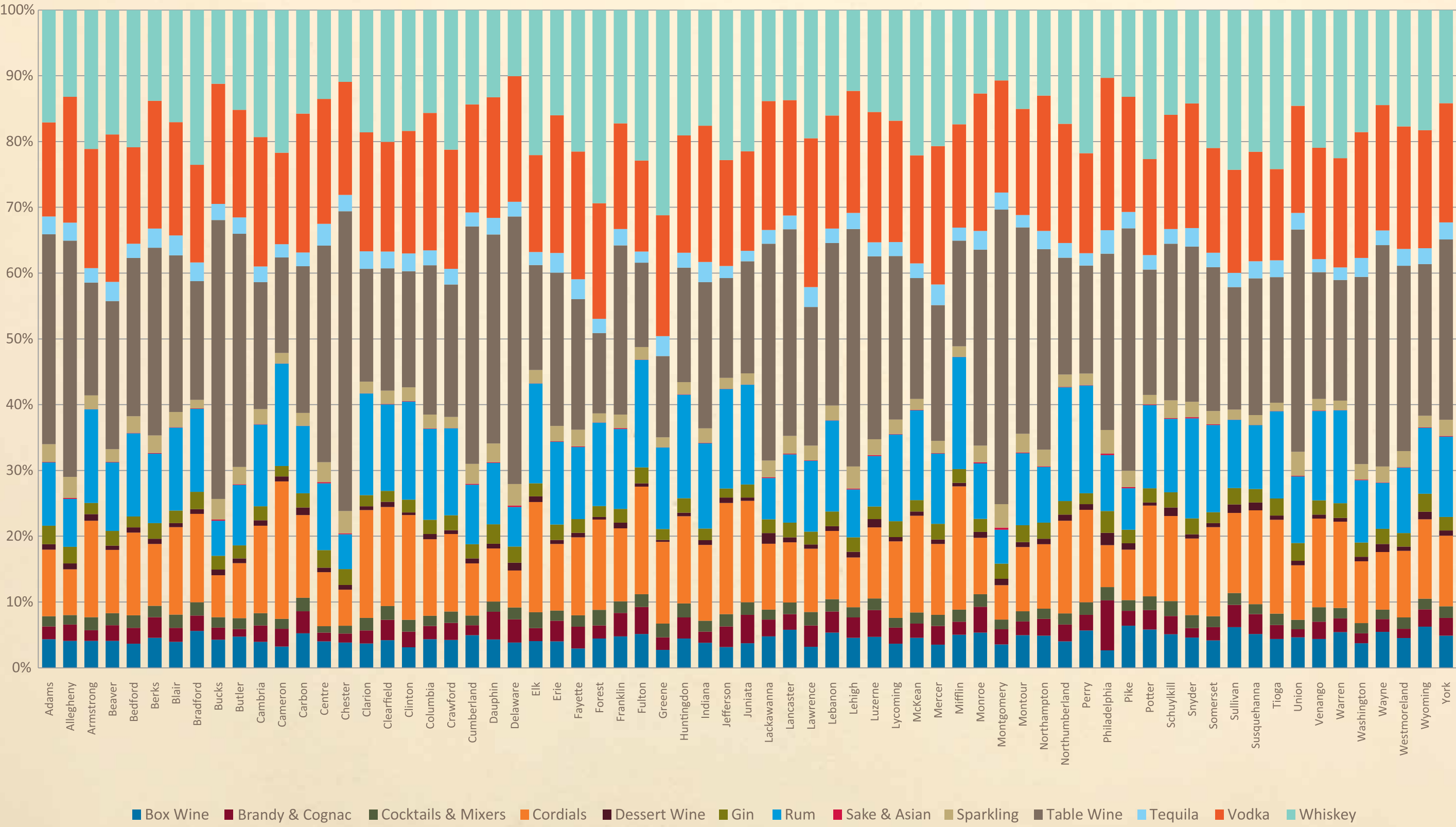

BRAND & ITEM PERFORMANCE

Brand and item performance provides an overview of trends related to shopper preferences and interests. From these measures, trends as well as up and coming items can be observed. In addition, regional sales by brand and item are included to show the different tastes of consumers in different areas.

Table 9 displays the top 100 brands⁹ based on unit sales. At the top of the list is Jacquin's with 4,065,302 units sold. Bacardi (3,284,502), Sutter Home (3,206,885), Captain Morgan (3,134,738) and Smirnoff (3,133,630) are the brands that round out the top five.

Table 13 lists the top 100 items ranked by units sold for the retail year¹¹. Captain Morgan Original Spiced Rum 750 mL sold the most units (1,043,805). Jack Daniel's Black Label Whiskey 750 mL (912,566), Nikolai Vodka 375 mL (768,669), Vladimir Vodka 1.75 L (752,383) and Jägermeister Liqueur 750 mL (735,191) followed in the top 5. Sutter Home White Zinfandel 1.5 L (#9, 639,949), Cavit Pinot Grigio 1.5 L (#12, 546,180), Kendall-Jackson VR Chardonnay 750 mL (#16, 523,941) and Woodbridge Chardonnay 1.5 L (#26, 395,621) were the top ranking wines.

The interest in moscato has remained strong from the past year. Barefoot Moscato 750 mL (186.65%) and Barefoot Moscato 1.5 L (102.38%) had two of the largest yearly increases. The other notable increases in units sold this year, among the top 100 items were Apothic Red 750 mL (155.18%), Skinnygirl Margarita Prepared Cocktail 750 mL (69.10%) and Smirnoff Vodka 1.75 L (54.20%)¹².

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Dollar sales for the top 100 items are displayed in Table 14. Captain Morgan Original Spiced Rum 1.75 L (\$19,410,911) and Jack Daniel's Black Label Whiskey 750 mL (\$19,016,311) were the top two items for the retail year. These two were followed by Captain Morgan Original Spiced Rum 750 mL (\$16,054,070), Grey Goose Vodka 750 mL (\$15,576,351) and Jägermeister Liqueur 750 mL (\$13,838,676).

Barefoot Moscato 1.5 L (106.44%) and Cîroc Coconut Vodka 750 mL (65.50%) had the greatest increase in dollar sales, of items with a prior year of sales. Larger size items continued to improve. Two 1.75 L items, ranked in the top 10, Smirnoff Vodka 1.75 L (53.41%) and Captain Morgan Original Spiced Rum 1.75 L (32.36%) displayed impressive growth¹³.

¹³Please note, Cîroc Peach Vodka 750 mL had no sales history from the previous year along with only 8 months of sales with the current year. Therefore the item has no year to year percentage change. Jack Daniel's Tennessee Honey 750 mL and Pinnacle Whipped Vodka 1.75 L had dramatic increases in dollar sales; however they did not have a full year of sales in the previous retail year.

The top items ranked by units sold by region are presented in Table 15, 16 and 17. Bacardi Superior Rum 750 mL, Jack Daniel's Black Label Whiskey 750 mL and Nikolai Vodka 375 mL appeared on the lists for each region. Kendall-Jackson VR Chardonnay (12.20%) had the largest increase in units sold for Region 1. Captain Morgan Original Spiced Rum 1.75 L (33.86%, 33.05%) had the greatest increase for Region 2 and Region 3.

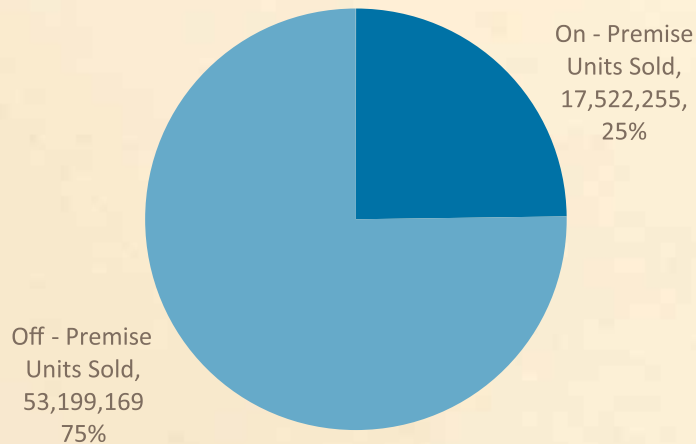

SPIRITS DETAILS

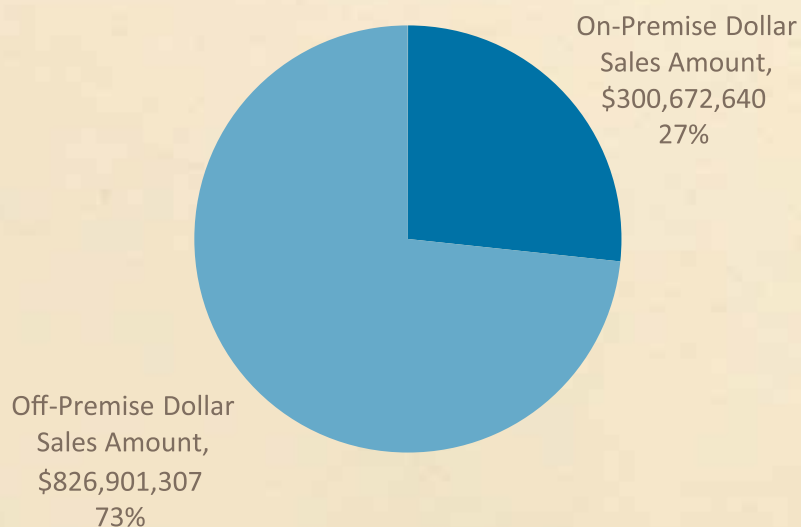
In this section, spirits will be examined more closely. By providing specifics on spirits details, the types of purchases, price segments, top items and trends can be display without comparison to wine. Figure 6 compares the on-premise and off-premise sales of spirits¹⁴. Off-premise sales (75%) were the larger portion of business¹⁵.

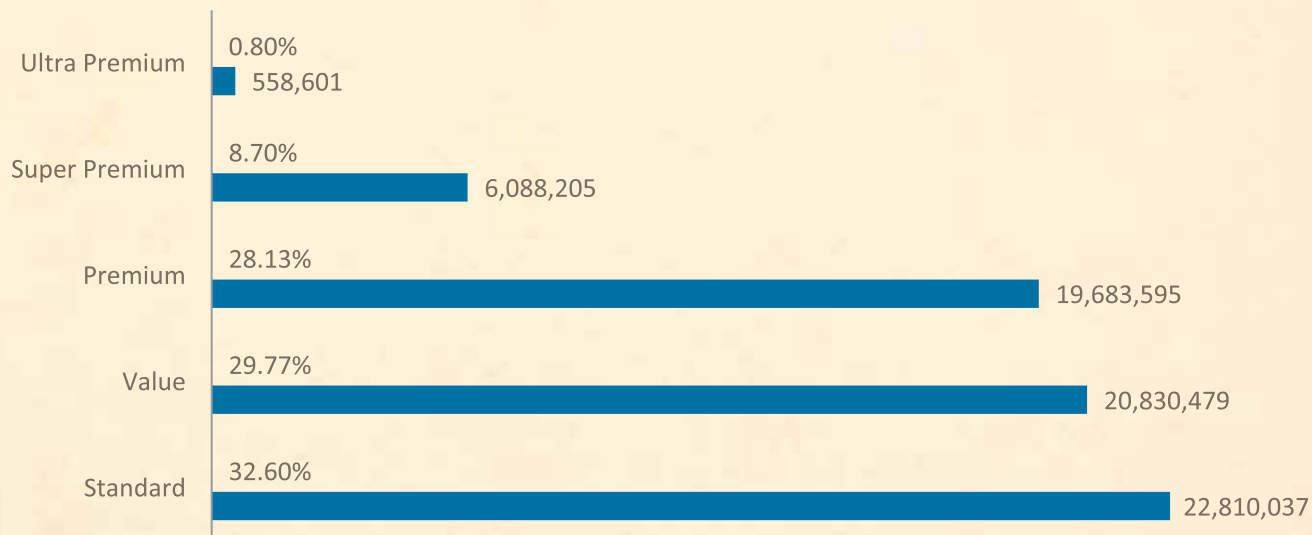
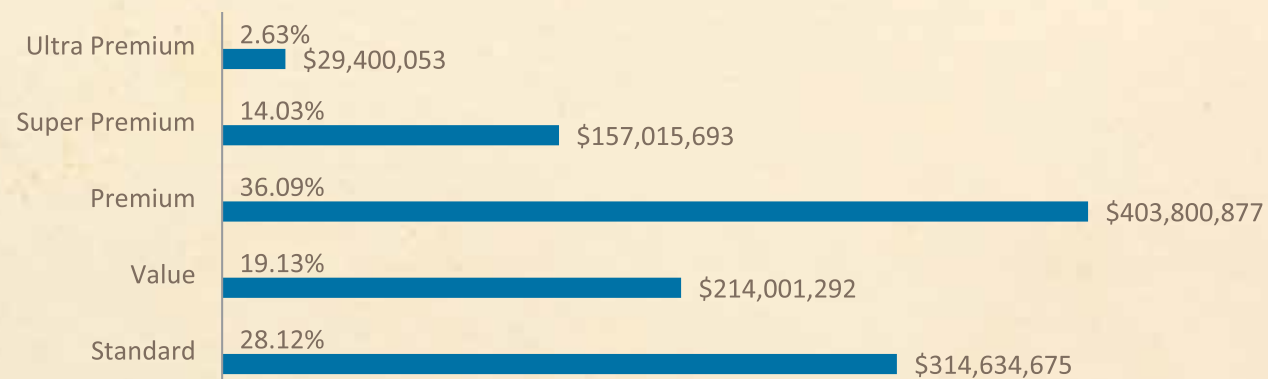


Figure 9: Spirits Dollars Sold by Price Segment, RY 2011 - 12

Figures 8 and 9 illustrate the performance of spirits by price segment in the previous retail year. During the previous year, the standard price segment had the most units (22,810,037) and premium had the most dollars (\$403,800,877) sold of any price segment. Figure 8: Spirits Units Sold by Price Segment, RY 2011 - 12

Figure 10: On - Premise and Off - Premise Units Sold - Wine Category, RY 2011 - 12

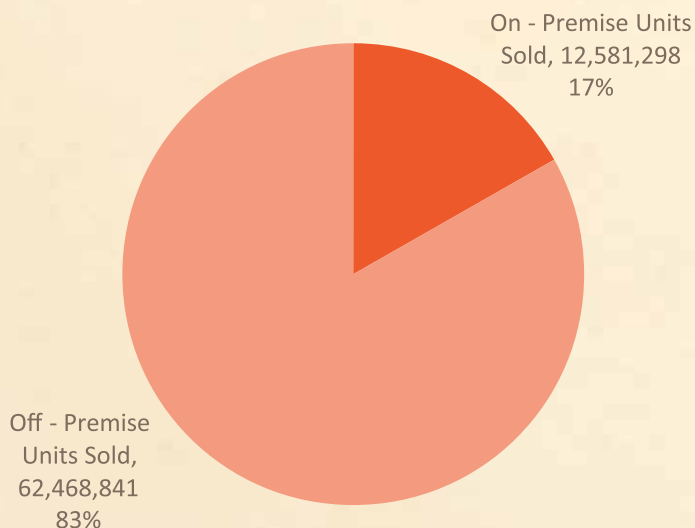
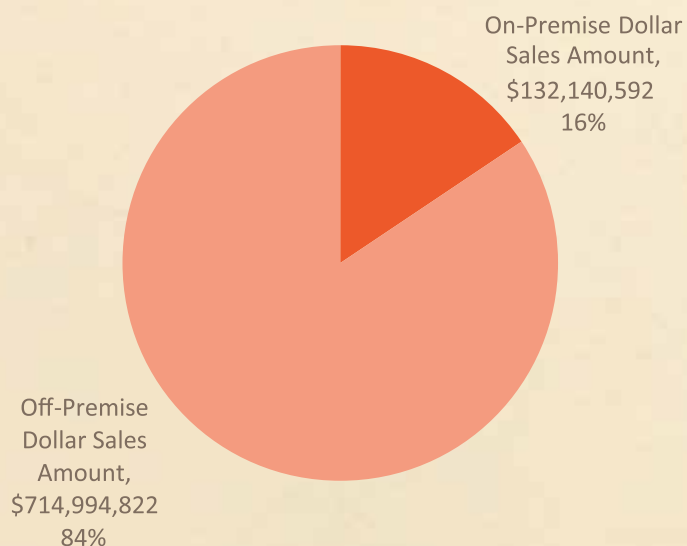


Figure 11: On-Premise and Off-Premise Dollar Sales, Wine Category, RY 2011 - 12

Figure 12: Imported and Domestic Table Wine, by Dollar Sales Amount, RY 2011 - 12

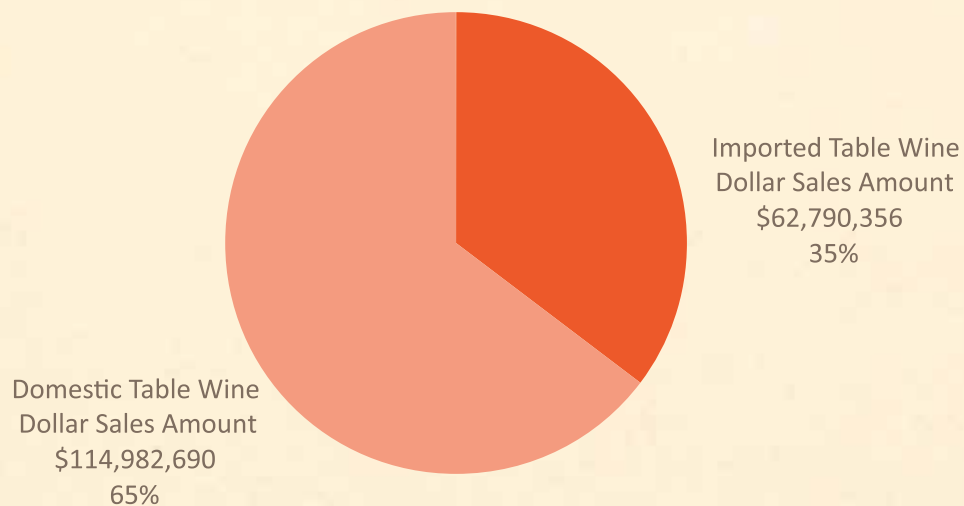
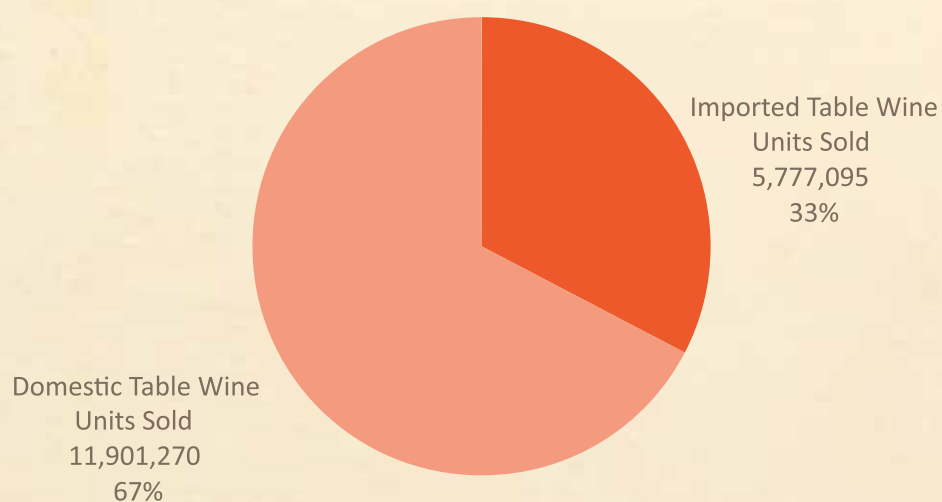


Figure 13: Imported and Domestic Table Wine by Units Sold, RY 2011 - 12

Figure 14: Wine Units Sold by Price Segment, RY 2011 - 12

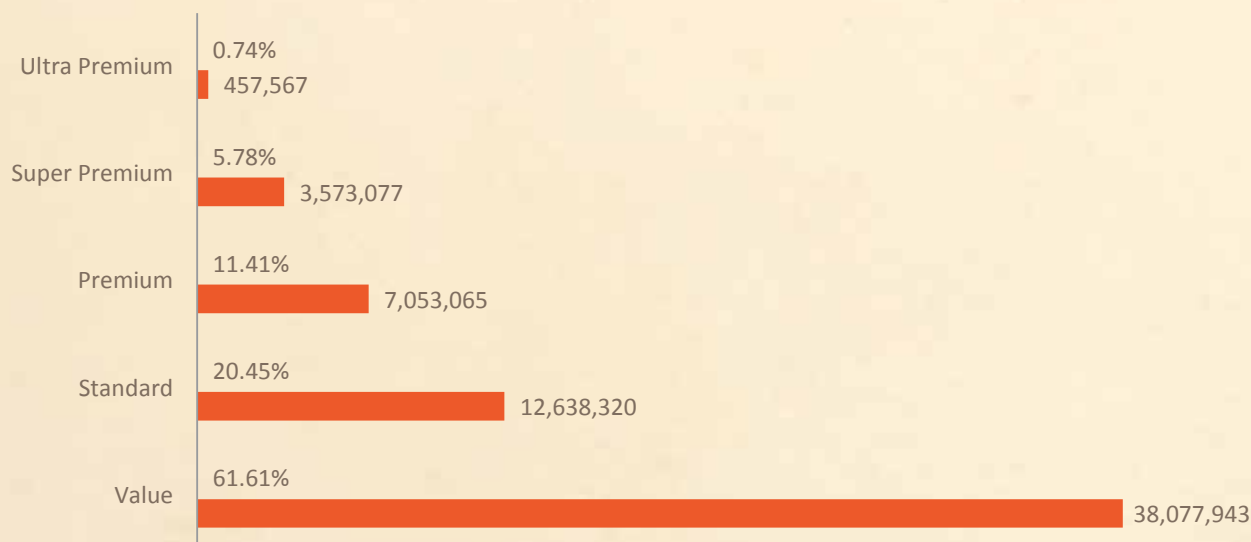
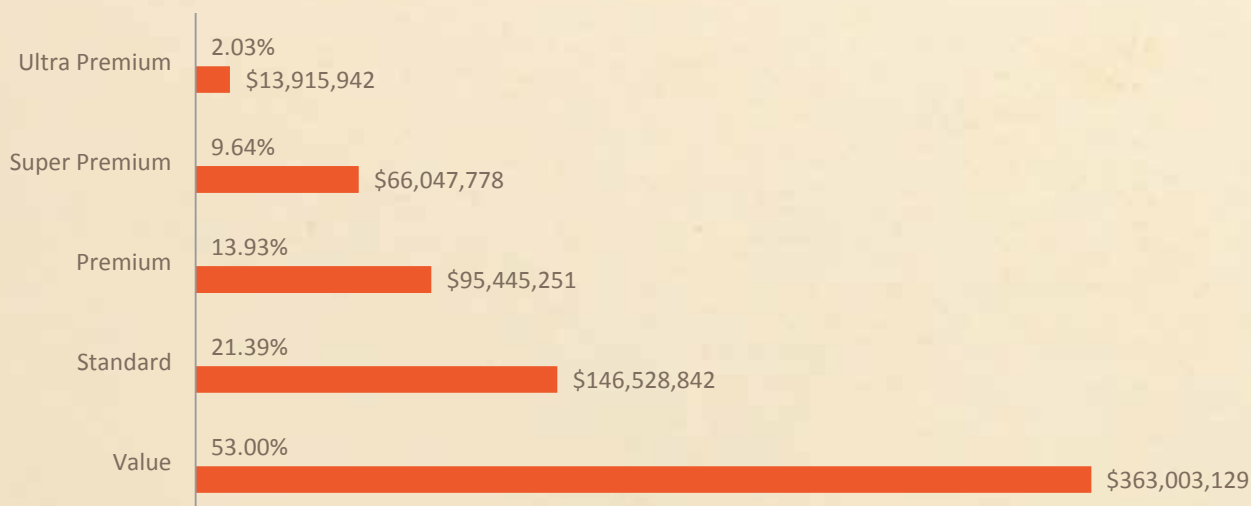


Figure 15: Wine Dollar Sales by Price Segment, RY 2011 - 12

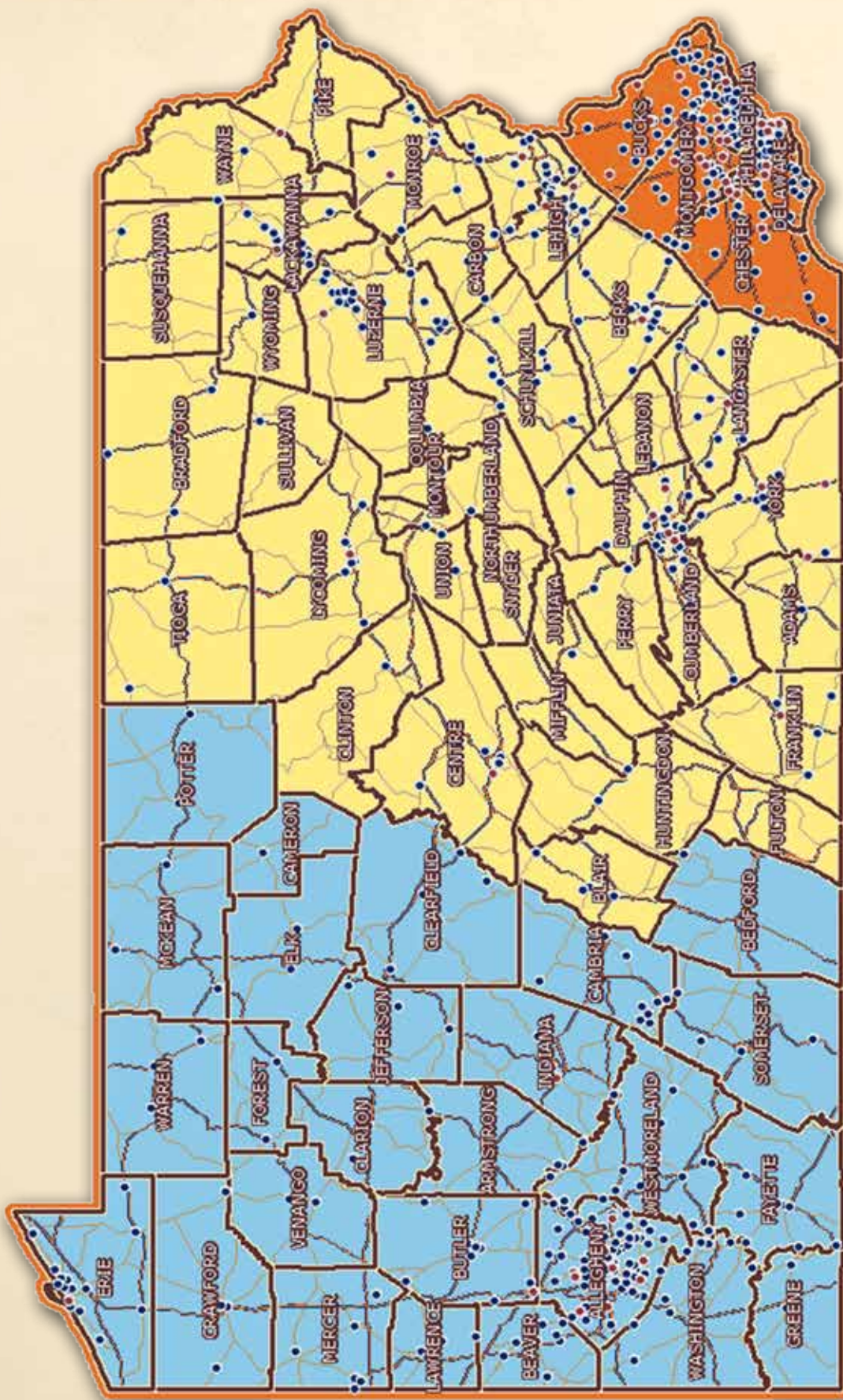
