



Availability: Approximately 25 positions will be filled by 1L and 2L law students.

Hours/Pay: Positions are based on a full-time 37.5 hour work week (2026 wages TBD / 2025 hourly rate: \$22.95).

Locations: The majority of positions are available in Harrisburg; however, limited positions are available in regional offices in Pittsburgh (4), the Philadelphia area (3), and Scranton/Wilkes-Barre (1).

What the Job Entails: Interns will work in a hybrid remote/ three (3) days in-office environment in the Offices of Chief Counsel for the various agencies served by OGC. They will be performing work that is typical of entry-level OGC lawyers, with an emphasis on legal research and writing, under the supervision and guidance of experienced OGC attorneys.
