**Evaluator Note**: Scenario will be a single-vehicle extrication incident on a two-lane roadway involving a common passenger vehicle positioned on its wheels. Candidates will have 30 minutes to complete this station.

**Directions**: Given a single vehicle extrication incident, PPE, and background information, the candidate, working as a team, will size up the incident, identify incident hazards, initiate isolation and scene control procedures, assist a rescue team by managing traffic flow, and recognize the need for technical rescue resources, so that the incident scene is isolated and controlled, additional resource needs are identified and requested, and incident hazards are communicated. Do you have any questions?

Performance Outcome: Pass / Fail is determined by 28 of 28 tasks correctly performed.
