# **Open Challenge:**

All skills are mandatory through the open challenge process. To begin, candidates must submit a completed application, which will be reviewed for accuracy. Once the application is successfully processed, the candidate will receive the necessary documents from the Pennsylvania State Fire Academy (PSFA) to achieve the required skills based on the Urtown Fire & Emergency Services organization standards.

Skills A, B, and C are in-person skills that can be tested at the PSFA or an approved Fire Officer I test site.

Once all required skills are completed, the documentation should be sent to the Pennsylvania State Fire Academy, ATTN: Certification. At that point, the candidate can schedule a test at the State Fire Academy or an approved test site.

## **Post-Course Challenge:**

To certify by this method, you **MUST** successfully complete a Fire Officer I course of instruction approved by the State Fire Academy within one (1) year of the date of this application. You **MUST** also successfully pass the written and practical skills and provide a current certification application. Applying, taking the written test, and completing the required practical skills are coordinated through an approved test site.

NOTE: You must submit a copy of your Fire Officer I course completion certificate with your application.
