

PA SAVIN is a free service that allows you to anonymously check an offender's custody status by phone, website, or mobile app. You can also register to receive automated notifications about changes in custody status by phone, email, text, or mobile app. TTY service for people with hearing loss is also available.

PA SAVIN Facts

- If you feel you are in danger, call 911 immediately.
- PA SAVIN provides information on offenders in custody in Pennsylvania.
- PA SAVIN calls automatically when an offender's custody status changes. You may get a call from PA SAVIN in the middle of the night.
- Write down your PIN and keep it in a safe place. For safety reasons, do not share this information with others.
- If you do not answer a notification call, PA SAVIN will leave a message and will continue calling back, up to 24-48 hours, or until you enter your PIN.
- Do not register a phone number that rings to a switchboard.
- You can register multiple phone numbers and email addresses for notifications.
- If you forget your PIN, call the toll-free number and press zero. You will be transferred to an operator who can help you reset your PIN, or cancel the notification.
- Operators are available 24/7 to assist you.

IF YOUR PHONE NUMBER OR EMAIL CHANGES, IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY to call PA SAVIN at 1-866-972-7284, or go to www.vinelink.com and follow the instructions on how to change your phone, text, or email registration. Unless you update your information, PA SAVIN will be unable to contact you when necessary.

Information

PA SAVIN is a service that lets victims of crime and other concerned citizens access timely and reliable information regarding offenders. PA SAVIN is offered free of charge to registrants, and features multiple language support.

Registration

If the offender is in custody, you can register to be notified about the following events:

- Offender Custody Status
- Probation/Parole Status

To access offender custody information and register to be notified:

- Call **1-866-972-7284**
- Visit **pcv.pccd.pa.gov** or **www.vinelink.com**
- Download the **VINELink mobile app**
- TTY users, call **1-866-847-1298**

Notification

The PA SAVIN service allows you to select your preferred notification method:

- Phone
- Text
- Mobile App
- Email
- TTY

Phone Notifications

If registering a phone number, you will be asked to create a four-digit personal identification number (PIN). When PA SAVIN calls, listen to the message. The PIN will be used to confirm that the call was received. Make sure your PIN is easy to remember.



Notification Events

Once you are registered, PA SAVIN will notify you of offender status changes, such as:

- Release
- Transfer
- Escape
- Advance notice prior to release
- Death
- Work release
- Furlough
- Probation/parole information

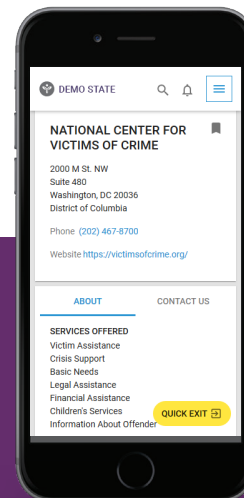
