# Track-Kit

Track-Kit is Pennsylvania's new statewide cloud-based system that allows **secure, real-time tracking of sexual assault kits (SAKs; sometimes called rape kits)**, helping ensure care and accountability at every step of the process and providing survivors with access to information about their kit.



Track-Kit was selected to meet the requirements of **Act 122 of 2024**, which directs Pennsylvania to implement a statewide electronic tracking system administered by PCCD.

## How Does Track-Kit Work?

### Confidential & Secure Survivor Access

- Survivors can confidentially view their kit's status online
- Access is provided at no cost to survivors
- Users log in with a barcode and password, no personal identifying information is required

## Strengthening the System

### Creating a More Coordinated & Efficient Response

- Improves accountability and oversight
- Reduces risk of lost or untested kits
- Promotes consistent statewide practices
- Enhances collaboration between system partners like law enforcement, healthcare providers, and forensic laboratories

**Important:** Track-Kit provides status updates only. It does not include forensic testing results. Survivors should contact the investigating agency for results.

## Implementation Timeline

<b>System Configuration:</b>	In Progress
<b>Pilot Launch:</b>	Summer 2026
<b>Full Implementation:</b>	By End of 2026

## Through OVS, Pennsylvania:

- Supports training and coordination across victim-serving systems
