Speeding and other aggressive driving behaviors are among the leading factors of highway crashes and fatalities in Pennsylvania. However, many motorists don't realize they are aggressive drivers. Excessive speeding, tailgating, racing to beat red lights or running stop signs, weaving in and out of traffic, passing illegally on the right, and failing to yield the right of way to oncoming vehicles are all factors in aggressive driving.
