Banner Permits

Borough of Troy
Resolution

WHEREAS, The Borough of Troy obtains banner permits for the erection of banners across state Highways located within the Borough; and

WHEREAS, The Borough of Troy desires to pass this resolution, which includes all banners, erected in the Borough of Troy on a yearly basis;



NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Borough of Troy, County of Bradford, does herewith Provide the following information as required by the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation for all the following banner permits to be erected annually as stated, with the Borough of Troy:

1. The locations will be as follows:
SR6 SEGMENT 150 OFFSET 1428
SR14 SEGMENT 360 OFFSET 470
SR 6 SEGMENT 160 OFFSET 639
2. Vertical ground clearance will be at a minimum of 17'6"
3. The size of the plastic banners will be: 2' wide by 10' long
The size of the Lighted garland will be: 2' wide by 20' long.
4. Event, Description of Message, Installation and Removal Dates:
 - a. Winterfest, "Winterfest, February _____", 2nd week in January, 2nd week in February.
 - b. Maple Festival, "Maple Festival, April _____", 2nd week in April, 1st week in May.
 - c. Little League, "Little League Baseball Signups", 2nd week in January, 2nd week in February.
 - d. Troy Fair, "Troy Fair July _____", 1st week in July, 1st week in August.
 - e. Heritage Fall Festival, "Heritage Fall Festival, Alparon Park, September _____", 1st week in September, 4th week in September.
 - f. Lighted Garland with clear lights, 3rd week in November, 2nd week in January.
5. Commercial Advertising will be no more than twenty percent (20%) of the message
6. Permanent cables will be used in the erection of the banners.
7. Traffic Control for erecting and removing the banner will be in accordance with the most current PENNDOT Publication for Work Zone Traffic Control.
8. The Borough of Troy Assumes the Responsibility for erecting, maintaining, and removing the banners
9. The Borough Agrees to Indemnify and Hold Harmless the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation and Department Employees from liability for damages or injury to any persons or property associated with the placement of banners
10. The Borough Authorizes the following herewith identified: Jerry May, Council President, Dan Close, Borough Manager, to execute any and all documents as may be required by the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation.
