



DAVEY HILL ROAD REPAIRS, WARREN COUNTY

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The purpose of the project is to repair Davey Hill Road (Route 3007) in Deerfield Township at the location of two active slides that have caused the roadway to fail. The slide repairs will include excavating the failing area and placing stone filled gabion baskets to support the roadway.

Approximately 400 vehicles a day use this portion of roadway, on average.

PROJECT AREA

The project is located in Deerfield Township, Warren County. The slides are located approximately 2.8 miles and 4.9 miles northeast of the Tidioute Borough line.



PROPOSED PLAN

The project will include excavation and placement of stone-filled gabion baskets to create a retaining wall to support the failing portions of roadway. Work will also include roadway reconstruction and updated guide rail.

All proposed work will be performed within the existing PennDOT right-of-way.

ANTICIPATED CONSTRUCTION

Work is expected to occur during the 2026 construction season and will last approximately two weeks for each slide. The estimated construction cost is \$100,000 to \$300,000.



TRAFFIC IMPACTS

Traffic will be detoured during construction and is expected to be in place for approximately two weeks for each of the two locations.

The proposed 14.5-mile out of travel detour route will be posted using Route 27 (Youngsville Road) and Morrison Hill Road (Route 3011).



CURRENT PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD

The purpose of the public comment period is to introduce the project and receive input regarding any questions or concerns with the project. It is also an opportunity for the public to review and comment on the project's potential effect upon Cultural Resources pursuant to the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation's 36 CFR Part 800 regulations implementing Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act. The project documents can be made available in alternative languages or formats if requested.
