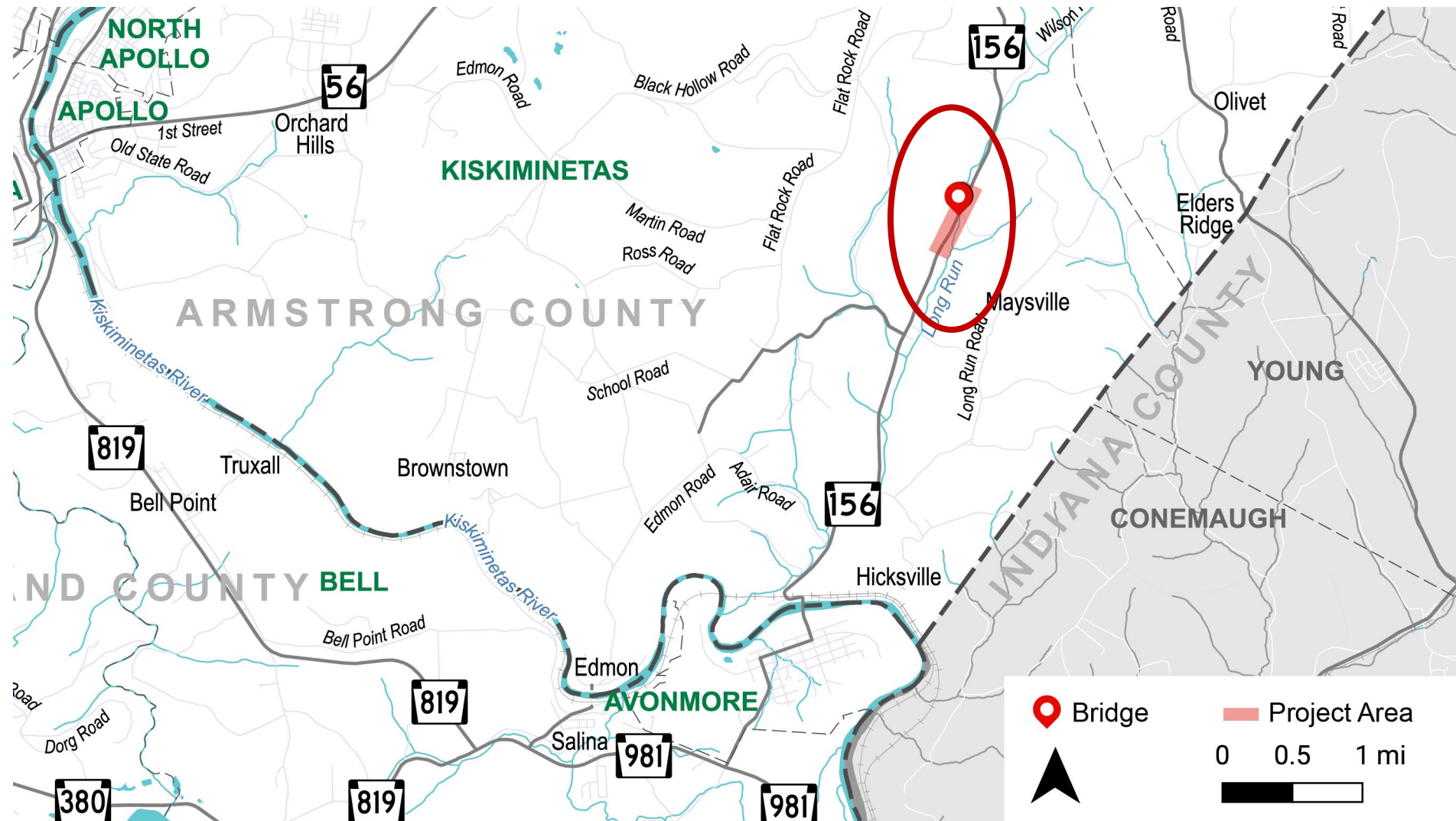

- Project is located on State Route 0156 in Kiskiminetas Township, Armstrong County.
- Approximately 3 miles north of Avonmore.

- **Purpose**

- Replace the existing bridge carrying Route 156 over Long Run and relocate a portion of the existing stream.
- This work will also include raising the existing roadway profile and all associated approach roadway reconstruction in Kiskiminetas Township, Armstrong County.

- **Need**

- The existing bridge structure is deteriorated, and significant erosion is present at the current structure due to the skew.



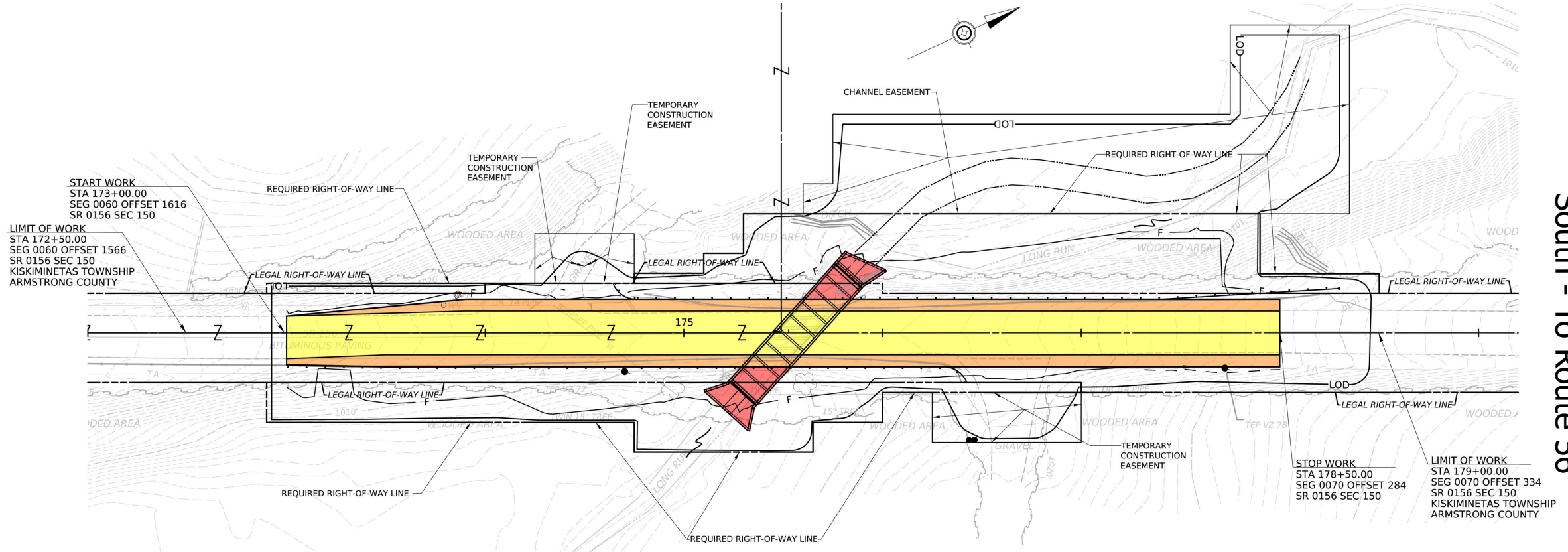
RECONSTRUCTION LIMITS

South - To Maysville

West – Orchard Hills

East - Olivet

South - To Route 56

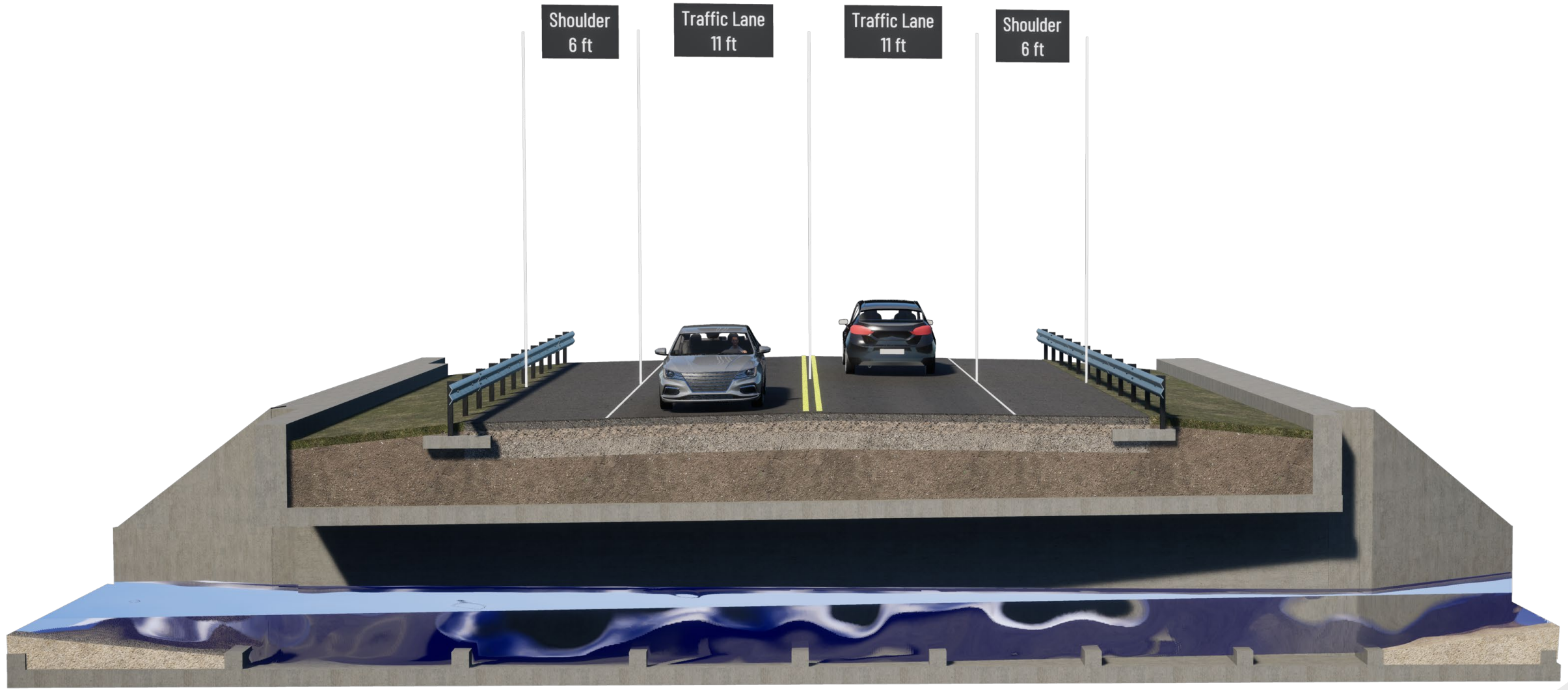


PROJECT DETAILS

- Provide new Precast Reinforcement Concrete Box Culvert on SR 156
- Remove bridge weight posting
- Utilize accelerated bridge construction methods to construct new culvert in 3 weeks under detour
- Realign existing stream (Long Run)
- Upgrade guide rail safety
- Avoid environmental impacts
- Minimize property and utility impacts



BRIDGE TYPICAL SECTION



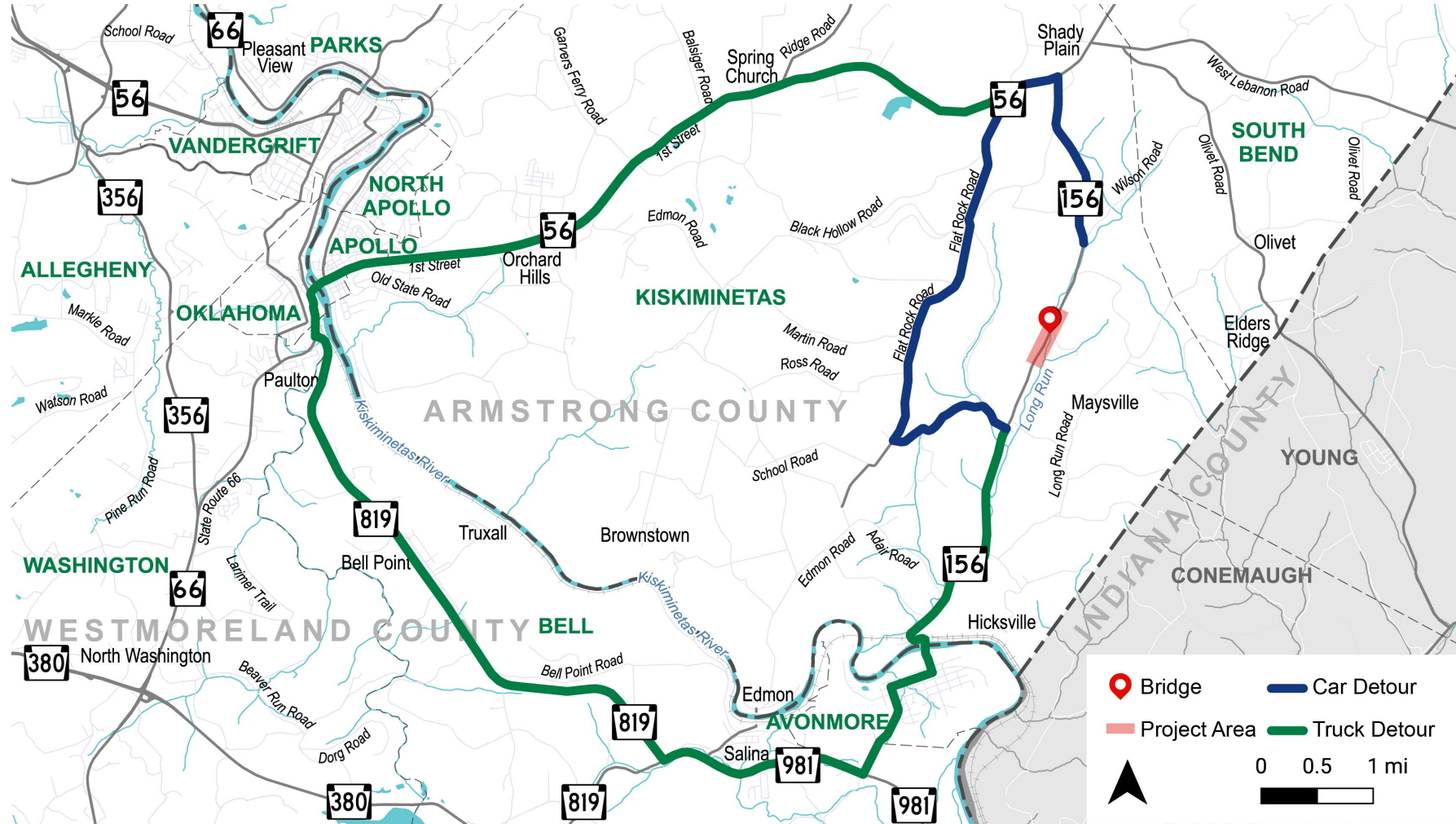
TEMPORARY DETOUR - CARS

NB SR 156 Car Detour

- Turn left, heading west on Allhouse Road
- Turn right, onto Flat Rock Road heading north
- Turn right, heading east on PA 56 to PA 156

SB SR 156 Car Detour

- Turn right, heading west on PA 56
- Turn left, on Flack Rock Road heading south
- Turn left, head east on Allhouse Road to PA 156



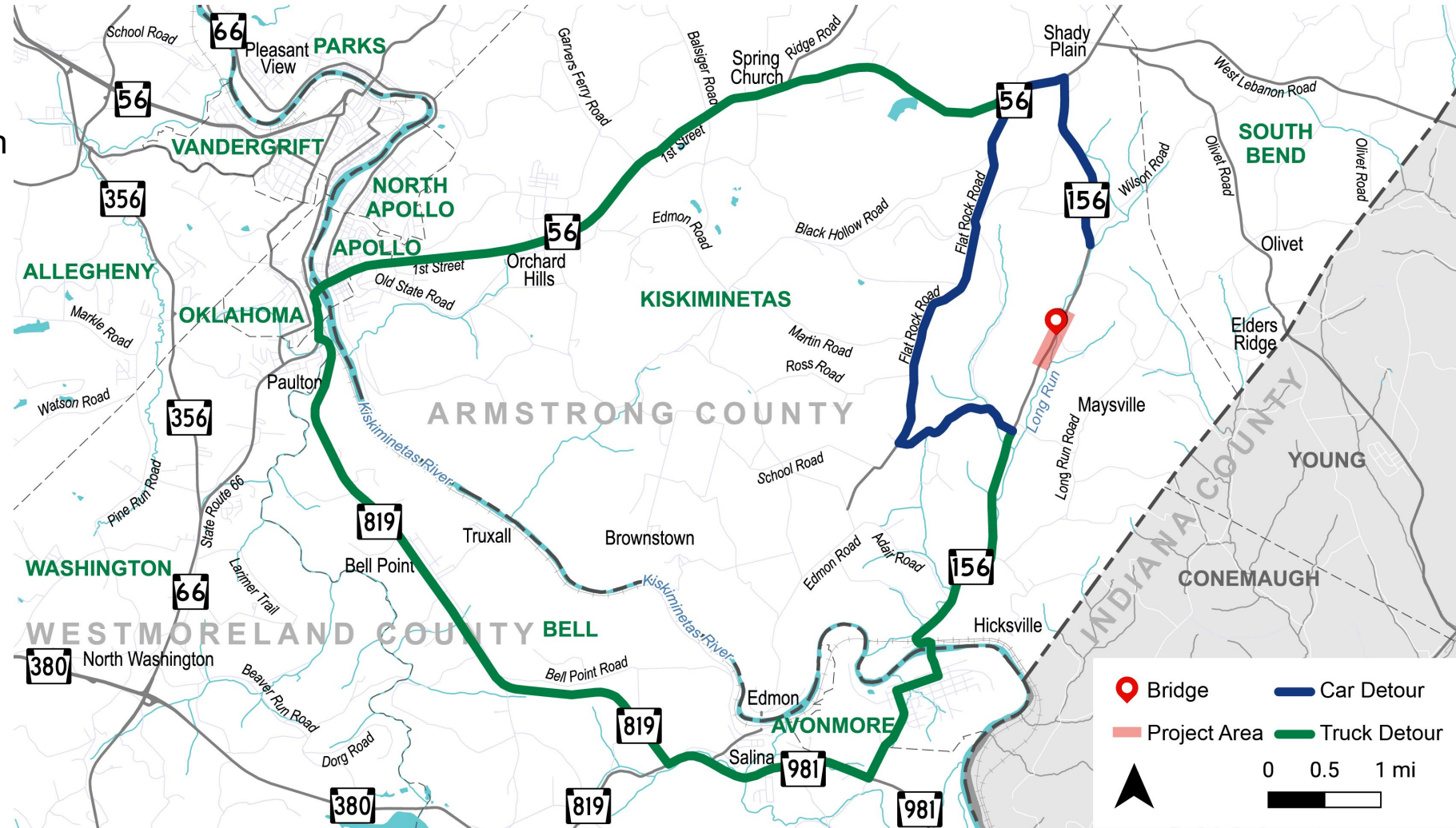
TEMPORARY DETOUR - TRUCKS

NB SR 156 Truck Detour

- Head west on PA 981
- Turn right, heading northwest on PA 819
- Continue north to PA 66
- Continue north/northeast onto 1st Street
- Continue straight onto PA 56 heading east
- Turn right onto PA 156

SB SR 156 Truck Detour

- Head west on PA 56
- Continue onto 1st Street
- Continue southeast to PA 66
- Continue southeast to PA 819
- Turn left, heading east on PA 819
- Turn left onto PA 156



PROJECT SCHEDULE

- Preliminary Engineering Underway
- Final Design in 2026
- Advertisement Tentatively Set for Early 2028
- Construction Tentatively Set for Spring 2029
