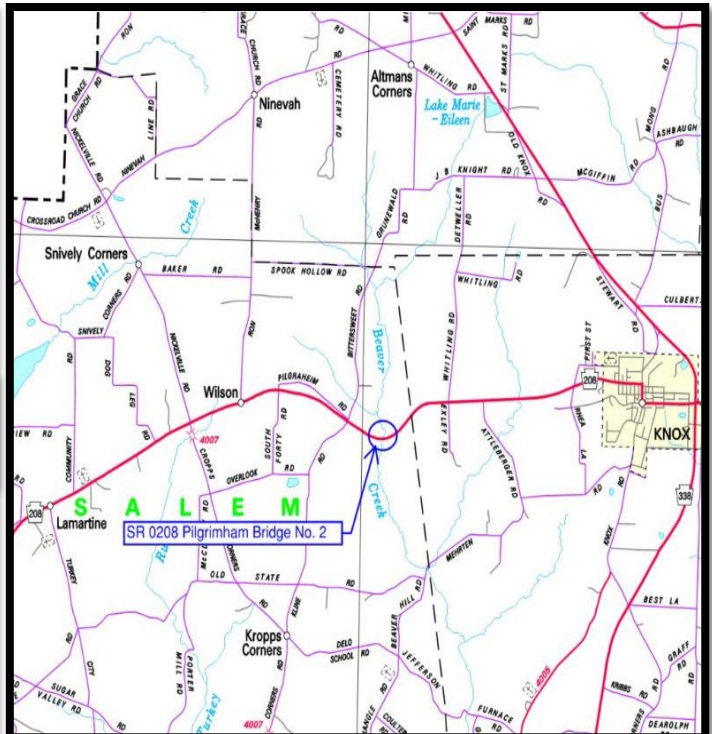

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The proposed project includes the replacement of the existing structure carrying SR 0208 over Beaver Creek in Clarion County, PA.

PROJECT LOCATION

The SR 0208 Section 354 project is located in Salem Township, Clarion County, PA. SR 0208 over Beaver Creek is located 2.1 miles west of Knox, PA serves as a connector between Knox to the east and Wilson to the west.



PROPOSED PLAN

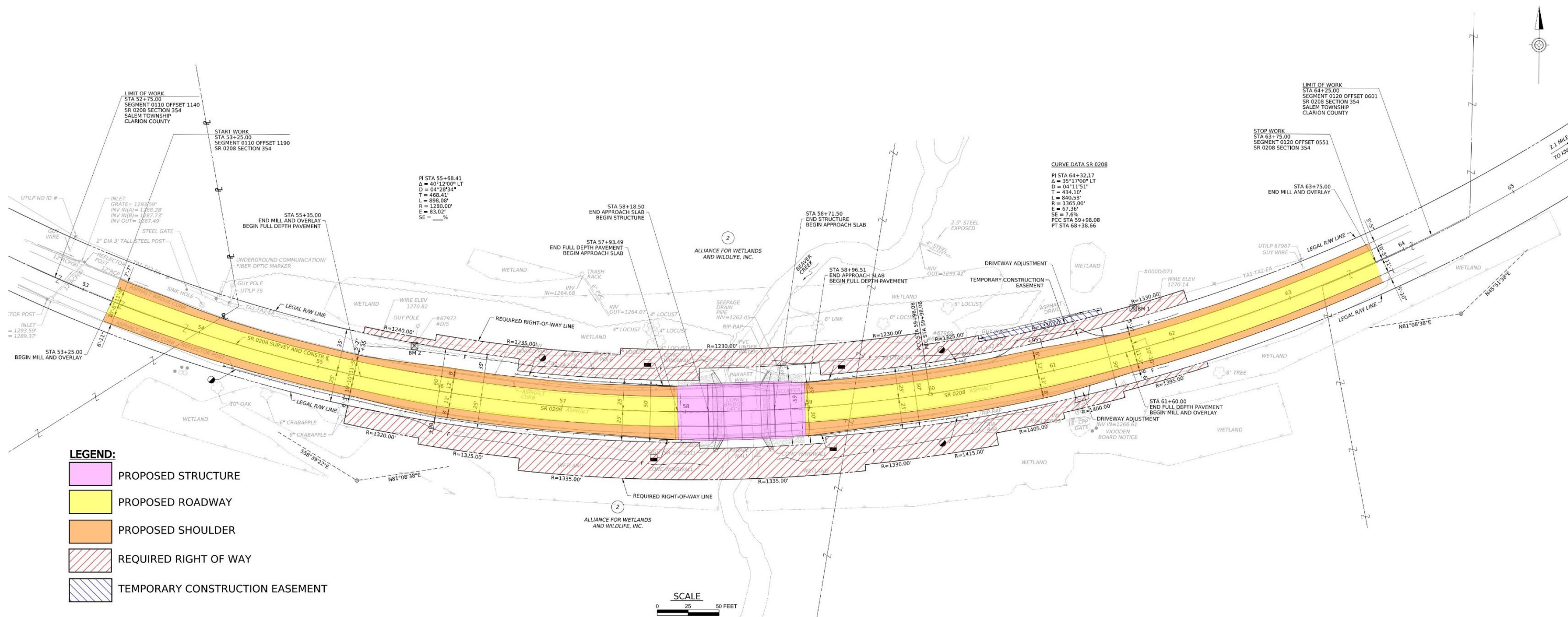
- Remove the existing fair condition single-span prestressed concrete adjacent box beam bridge.
 - Construct a proposed 50-foot long galvanized steel plate girder bridge with integral abutments.
 - Perform full-depth pavement reconstruction along SR 0208 for approximately 522 feet.
 - Perform mill and overlay pavement along SR 0208 for approximately 425 feet.
 - Complete pavement marking, signing, and guide rail improvements.

ANTICIPATED PROJECTED SCHEDULE

Preliminary Engineering/Environmental Clearance Complete: Spring 2026

Final Design: Summer 2026 - Summer 2027

Construction: Fall 2027 - Fall 2028



PROPOSED TRAFFIC CONTROL

- Phased construction is the preferred method of traffic control.
- Temporary traffic signals will be used to maintain 1 lane of alternating traffic through the construction area.
- Anticipated length of construction is 1,050 ft and is anticipated to be 6 months long
