## Reconstruction of the intersection of State Route (SR) 6, SR 660 (Elk Run Road), and SR 4002 (Charleston Road) in Charleston Township, Tioga County

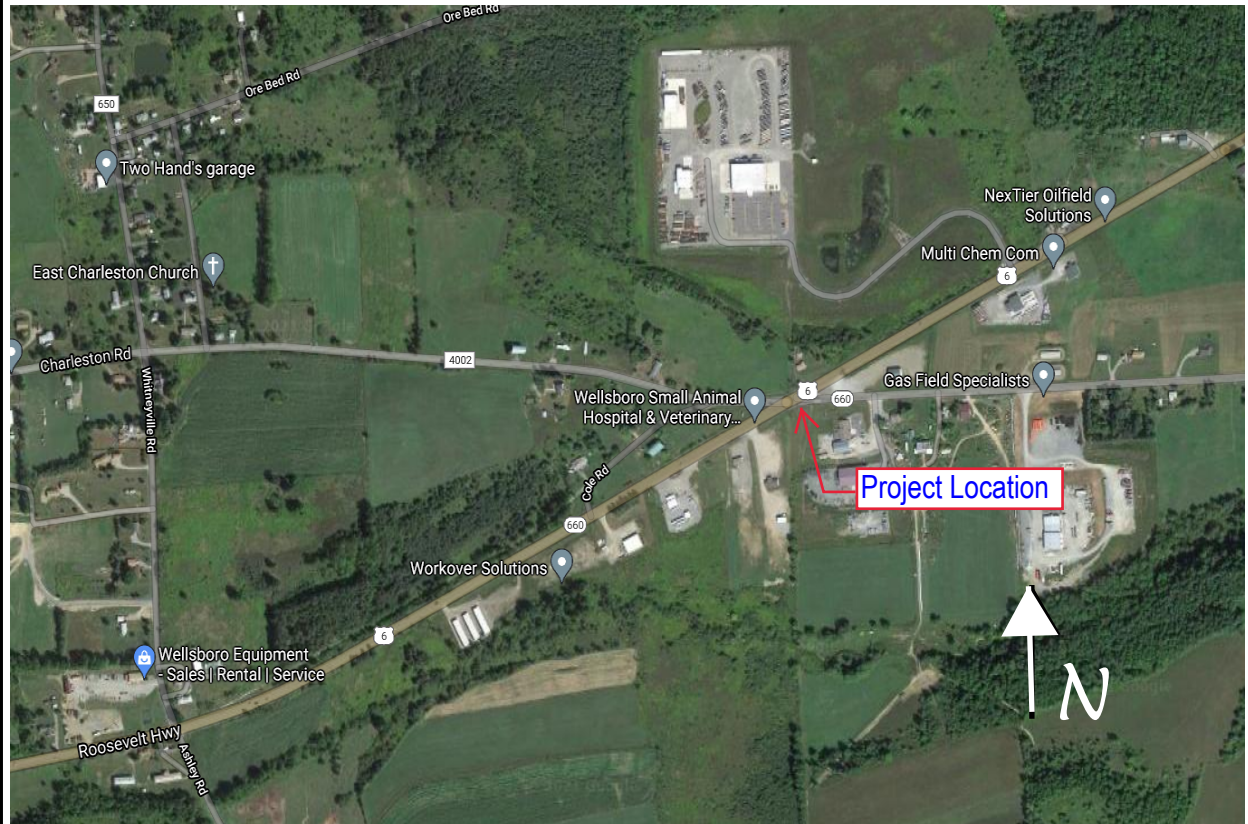
The intersection reconstruction project will convert the existing sharply skewed four-leg intersection of SR 6 / SR 660 / SR 4002 into two T-Intersections approximately 800 feet apart. Modifications to the intersection will improve safety by increasing intersection sight distance.

Project plans and project information will be available for review on the PennDOT District 3 web site and at the Charleston Township Building. In addition to project information, a comment form is included. Project construction is tentatively scheduled to begin in Spring 2023 and completed by Spring of 2024.

Construction will occur in stages, with traffic being maintained on the existing roadways. Limited detours will be used at various times to maintain traffic around the work area. Temporary traffic shifts and nighttime lane closures will be implemented to minimize construction impacts.
