

U.S. 422 CORRIDOR IMPROVEMENTS PROGRAM

U.S. 422 Projects in Design:

U.S. 422 Schuylkill River Bridge to Hanover Road (U.S. 422, Section M2B)

- Estimated Cost: \$116.1 million
- Estimated Let Date: Fall 2027

This project will reconstruct 1.5 miles of U.S. 422 including the replacement of three bridges carrying U.S. 422 over Laurelwood Road, Route 100, and Hanover Street; reconstruct the ramps at the Route 100 and Hanover Street Interchanges; and improve the outer acceleration and deceleration lanes at the Route 100 and Hanover Street Interchanges in North Coventry Township, Chester County. The project will also include noise mitigation in the form of sound barrier walls.



U.S. 422 Keim Street and Route 724 Interchanges (U.S. 422, Section M03)

- Estimated Cost: \$83 million
- Estimated Let Date: Fall 2028

This project will reconstruct U.S. 422 from 2,370 feet west of Keim Street to the Schuylkill River Bridge including two bridges, concrete median barrier, and acceleration and deceleration lanes at the Keim Street and Route 724 interchanges in North Coventry Township, Chester County.
