

PROJECT OVERVIEW

- Replacement of an existing bridge with a new steel or prestressed concrete beam bridge carrying Marshall Road over Cobbs Creek.
- Pavement reconstruction at bridge approaches propose 12' lanes, a 4' median, 9' shoulders/multi-purpose lanes, and 6' sidewalks. Replace existing guide rail.
- Bridge to be constructed in multiple stages. Two-Way traffic will be maintained during construction.
- Pedestrian access will be maintained during construction.
- The existing walking trail will be closed under the bridge during construction and will be detoured along the parkway to the Cobbs Creek Recreation Center.




PROJECT MAP





