

Project Description

The project includes rehabilitation of the superstructure of the Route 22 bridge (Allentown Boulevard) over Reeds Creek in East Hanover Township, Lebanon County. The purpose of this project is to provide a continued safe and efficient crossing on Route 22 over Reeds Creek.

The project includes rehabilitation of the existing superstructure. Superstructure repairs include repairs to the existing headwalls. The horizontal and vertical geometries of the roadway will remain unchanged.

Environmental

The project is located in a rural setting. No bicycle or pedestrian facilities exist within project limits. Other environmental efforts for the project include investigating historical, archeological, and aquatic resources as well as threatened and endangered species.

Utilities

There are no anticipated utilities impacts within the project limits. No utilities are anticipated to be relocated prior to construction.

Right-of-way

Permanent and/or temporary right-of-way acquisitions are not anticipated for this project.

Maintenance and Protection of Traffic

Staged temporary traffic control will be implemented for the duration of construction for Route 22.

Schedule and Cost

Overall construction is anticipated to last approximately 4 months starting in the Fall of 2026 or Spring of 2027 at an estimated cost of \$150,000.
