

## **Project Description**

The project includes rehabilitation of the superstructure of the Route 934 bridge (S. White Oak Street) over Quittapahilla Creek in Annville Township, Lebanon County. The purpose of this project is to provide a continued safe and efficient crossing on Route 934 over Quittapahilla Creek.

The project includes rehabilitation of the existing superstructure. Superstructure repairs include painting of the existing beam ends and installation of surface mounted galvanic anodes at beam ends to prevent further corrosion. The horizontal and vertical geometries of the roadway will remain unchanged.

## **Environmental**

The project is located in an urban setting. No bicycle facilities exist within project limits, however, pedestrian sidewalks are present within project limits. No more than one sidewalk at a time may be temporarily closed during construction. Other environmental efforts for the project include investigating historical, archeological, and aquatic resources as well as threatened and endangered species.

## **Utilities**

There are no anticipated utilities impacts within the project limits. No utilities are anticipated to be relocated prior to construction.

## **Right-of-way**

Permanent and temporary right-of-way acquisitions are not anticipated for this project.

## **Maintenance and Protection of Traffic**

Temporary traffic control will involve shifting traffic lanes during construction on Route 934. Two lanes of traffic will be maintained at all times during construction.

## **Schedule and Cost**

Overall construction is anticipated to last approximately 4 months starting in the Fall of 2026 or Spring of 2027 at an estimated cost of \$250,000.
