

EXISTING PROJECT CONDITIONS



PURPOSE AND NEED

Bridge preservation projects involve construction activities that are vital to extending the life of existing bridges and infrastructure. Safety improvements will also be made to bring guiderail and drainage up to current standards. Bridge deck seals wear out and degrade over time which allows water to infiltrate areas that are otherwise sealed off. This water can cause damage over time and lead to failing concrete and corrosion of reinforcement. Repairing these problems now will slow the degradation of the structure from natural elements and traffic, extending the service life of the bridges involved.

PURPOSE AND NEED / TRAFFIC CONTROL

For this project, traffic will be maintained on the structures during repair utilizing short-term single lane closures.

PROJECT SCHEDULE

Work for this project is expected to begin the week of June 8th. Work at each site should take approximately 3 weeks, but lane closures likely will not be present for the entire duration of this time. The order in which each site will be addressed will be decided by the contractor, work could extend as late as 12/31/26.
