 - Route 21 with Georges Road/Glade Run Road in Cumberland Township, Greene County
 - Morganza Road with McClelland Road in Cecil Township, Washington County
 - Morganza Road with Southpointe Boulevard in Cecil Township, Washington County
 - This will be accomplished by changing the traffic signal heads to flashing yellow arrow (FYA) control. These signal heads enhance safety by showing drivers that they need to use caution when making a left turn during the flashing yellow arrow phase.

- Work will be completed using single-lane closures with flaggers
- No detours are anticipated for this project
