# Operating a Farm Vehicle Using a Farm Vehicle Registration Plate

#### **PURPOSE**

This fact sheet explains farm vehicles operating requirements when registered with a Farm Vehicle registration plate.

## PENNSYLVANIA VEHICLE CODE SECTIONS

102, 1344, 1924(a), 2105, 4307(e), 4702, 4921(b)(1)(5)

### **DEFINITIONS**

Farm Vehicle – A truck or truck tractor determined by the Department of Transportation to be used exclusively for agricultural purposes.

#### **USE**

A truck or truck tractor bearing farm vehicle registration plates shall be used exclusively upon a farm or farms owned or operated by the registrant of the vehicle or upon highways between:

- 1. Parts of one such farm.
- 2. Such farms.
- 3. Such a farm or farms and a place of business for the purpose of buying or selling agricultural commodities or supplies.
- 4. Such place of business, if transported to the place of business pursuant to paragraph (3) and the place of delivery of the agricultural commodities, provided that:
  - i. delivery is made pursuant to the sale of the commodities by the registrant of the vehicle, by an employee of the vehicle registrant or by an auctioneer; and,
  - ii. if transported to the place of business pursuant to paragraph (3), delivery is made by the same vehicle of the registrant which transported the commodities to the place of business.
- 5. Such farm or farms and a department site for the examination of an applicant for a driver's license.
- 6. Such farm or farms and a place of business for the inspection, repair or servicing of the vehicle.

#### SIZE LIMITATIONS

Generally, no wider than 8 feet 6 inches.

#### **INSPECTION REQUIREMENTS**

Farm vehicles are subject to an annual vehicle safety inspection.

#### REGISTRATION

Fees: For a current listing of motor vehicle fees, refer to Form MV-70S, "Bureau of Motor Vehicles Schedule of Fees," found on our website at www.pa.gov/dmv.

You may be eligible to renew your motor vehicle for either a one-year or two-year registration period. Both registration periods and the required fees are provided on the registration renewal.
