## Most Common Reasons for Title and Registration Application Rejections

### PURPOSE

This fact sheet lists some of the main reasons why title and registration applications are rejected by PennDOT and returned to applicants.

### REASONS

1. Insufficient fees remitted.
2. Lien information not completed in its entirety.
3. Notarization required.
4. Inaccurate information was provided.
5. Gross Vehicle Weight Rating (GVWR) not listed for truck, truck-tractor and trailers.
6. Replacement Vehicle Identification Number (VIN) plate required.
7. Odometer reading not completed.
8. Insurance information is expired.
9. Transfer of registration is questionable.
10. Valid lien exists on title record.
11. Vehicle is already renewed.
12. Odometer discrepancy.
13. Certificate of title required.
14. Signature required.
15. Evidence of erasure or alterations.

Many applications are rejected a second, and in some instances, a third time because of noncompliance to the first rejection. Therefore, please carefully check your work prior to delivering or mailing applications to PennDOT for completeness and accuracy to avoid further rejections and delays in processing your work.
