To display a Historic Military Vehicle registration plate, the vehicle must already be branded as an antique or classic vehicle. If the vehicle is not branded as an antique or classic vehicle, you must also complete and submit Form MV-11, "Application for Permanent Antique, Classic or Collectible Registration Plates," and pay all applicable fees.

In lieu of an antique or classic registration plate, the owner of an antique or classic military motor vehicle may request permission from PennDOT to display a Historic Military Vehicle registration plate. There is an application fee for a Historic Military Vehicle registration plate. The use of a Historic Military Vehicle registration plate is governed by Section 1340 of the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code which states: "It is unlawful for any person to operate a motorcycle or vehicle with antique, classic, vintage, collectible or historic military vehicle registration plates for general daily transportation. Permitted use shall be limited to participation in club activities, exhibits, tours, parades, occasional transportation and similar uses." **Occasional transportation and similar uses is defined as no more than one day a week.**

Although buses and trucks are eligible for Historic Military Vehicle registration plates, buses **may not** be used to transport passengers and trucks **may not** haul cargo. Historic Military Vehicle motorcycle registration plates may only be displayed on antique or classic motorcycles. Historic Military Vehicle registration plates are not available for motorized pedalcycles or motor homes.

A Historic Military Vehicle registration plate may not be displayed on a vehicle used to transport people or property.

HISTORIC MILITARY VEHICLES

1. This form requires a fee. Please review the instructions below carefully prior to submitting the application. For a complete listing of motor vehicle fees, refer to [Form MV-70S, "Bureau of Motor Vehicles Schedule of Fees,"](#) found on the [Driver and Vehicle Services](#) website or scan the QR code on the front of this application. Payment is to be made by check or money order payable to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. **DO NOT SEND CASH.**
2. **Definitions**
 - A. "Historic Military Vehicle" - An antique or classic vehicle, that was manufactured for use in any country's military forces and is maintained to represent the vehicle's military design and markings accurately.
 - B. "Antique Motor Vehicle" - A motor vehicle, but not a reproduction thereof, manufactured more than 25 years prior to the current year which has been **maintained in or restored to** a condition which is substantially in conformance with manufacturer specifications.
 - C. "Classic Motor Vehicle" - A motor vehicle, but not a reproduction thereof, manufactured at least 15 years prior to the current year which has been **maintained in or restored to** a condition which is substantially in conformity with manufacturer specifications and appearance. Any classic motor vehicle registered under Section 1340 (relating to antique, classic and collectible registration plates) on the effective date of the amendment to this definition which fails to qualify as a classic motor vehicle pursuant to these provisions may retain such classic registration unless another type of registration is applied for and issued for the vehicle.
3. **Expiration of Historic Military Vehicle Registration Plates**

Historic Military Vehicle registration plates are permanent and are issued for the life of the vehicle while it is owned by the present owner. If the present owner sells the vehicle, the registration plate remains with the seller/owner and may be used on another qualified vehicle, provided the proper application and title fees are paid. However, if ownership is transferred between spouses, or between parent and child, the original registration plate may be transferred in the usual manner and a fee will be required.

If the owner sells the vehicle and wants to give the new owner the registration plate, the seller must write a letter of release for the registration plate and give it to the new owner. The new owner should forward the letter to the Bureau of Motor Vehicles, along with all appropriate documents and fees when applying for title and registration of the vehicle. The new owner must pay the full application fee of in order to use the registration plate. The transfer fee is not required in this case.

4. **Inspection**

Antique Historic Military Vehicles operated exclusively between sunrise and sunset are exempt from the normal lighting requirements of the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code, but must have their original lighting equipment and are not subject to the annual vehicle and emissions inspections. Classic Historic Military Vehicle are subject to annual safety inspections.

IF PERSONALIZING YOUR REGISTRATION PLATE

- Personalized registration plates may contain:



For **Historic Military Vehicle** registration plates, up to FOUR letters and/or numbers in combination. If a hyphen or space is used as part of the registration configuration, it counts as one of the available spaces for personalization. Only one hyphen or space is permitted, but not both. No additional special characters are available. Please use capital letters and print clearly. When requesting a numeric character of zero, please show as "Ø" instead of the alpha character "O." Since this is an electronically fillable form, after printing the form, please be sure any zero is marked with a "/." A pre-printed letter configuration of "MV" will precede your personalized configuration on your registration plate and cannot be changed.



For **Historic Military Vehicle Motorcycle** registration plates, up to THREE letters and/or numbers in combination. If a space is used as part of the registration configuration, it counts as one of the available spaces for personalization. Only one space is permitted. No hyphen or additional special characters are available. Please use capital letters and print clearly. When requesting a numeric character of zero, please show as "Ø" instead of the alpha character "O." Since this is an electronically fillable form, after printing the form, please be sure any zero is marked with a "/." A pre-printed letter configuration of "MV" will precede your personalized configuration on your registration plate and cannot be changed.

- PennDOT reserves the right to limit or reject requests.
- There is an additional fee to personalize your registration plate. Payment is to be made by check or money order payable to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. **PLEASE DO NOT SEND CASH.**
- To check personalized registration plate availability, visit PennDOT's Driver and Vehicle Services website www.pa.gov/dmv, and select Vehicle Services then Registration Plates and select [Personalized Registration Plates](#). Personalized registration plates will not be reserved until PennDOT receives payment and a completed application, and approves your requested registration plate configuration [number(s) and/or letter(s)]. Please note that registration plate requests are processed on a first-come, first-served basis. Although a requested registration plate configuration may show as being available on the website, it is possible that a request for the same registration plate configuration may have already been submitted by another customer and may not be available when making application.
- Personalized registration plates will be manufactured on the basis of this application. NO REFUND of the fee will be issued when an applicant cancels a request after the order is placed with the manufacturer.
- Allow 8 to 10 weeks for delivery.
