USE OF THIS FORM IS RESTRICTED TO ONLINE DEALER AUCTION STAFF AND AUTHORIZED TITLE PROVIDERS

This form is to be used **ONLY** to release an electronic lien, and **ONLY** when the vehicle is owned by a licensed PA dealer who is offering the vehicle for sale at a PA dealer auction. The purpose of this authorization is to allow a printed certificate of title to be given directly to the dealer named as owner on the title when the vehicle is located at a dealer auction for the purpose of resale.

D LIENHOLDER UNSWORN DECLARATION

I declare under penalty of perjury under the law of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania that the foregoing is true and correct. This authorization is for the purpose of providing a paper title to the named dealer in Section B for resale of the vehicle listed in Section A at the dealer auction listed in Section E.

Furthermore, I state that I have read and signed this application after its completion, and I swear or affirm that the statements made herein are true and correct, and that any statement made on or pursuant to this application is subject to the penalties of 18 Pa.C.S. Section 4904(a)(2) (relating to unsworn falsification), which include criminal prosecution and a term of imprisonment, the maximum of which may be one year [18 Pa.C.S. 4904(b)], or up to two years [18 Pa.C.S. 4904(a)]. In addition to any other penalty, a person convicted under this section shall be sentenced to pay a fine of at least \$1,000 [18 Pa.C.S. 4904(d)].

Instructions for Use of Form

Who May Complete the Form

- ❖ An authorized agent employed by a PA online dealer auction, PIADA or PAA.

When May the Form Be Used

- ❖ This form is to be used only when all the following conditions apply:
 1. The vehicle owner is a PA dealer, and is the owner on the PA vehicle record.
 2. The vehicle is financed, and a lien is recorded on the PA vehicle record.
 3. The current PA Certificate of Title is an Electronic Lien and Title (ELT).
 4. The vehicle is to be offered for sale at a PA dealer auction.

Completion of Form

- ❖ All sections of the form must be completed. No fields may be left blank.
- ❖ The form must be signed by a representative of the lienholder in the presence of the agent who issues the title.
- ❖ The form cannot be partially completed by the lienholder, then mailed, faxed or e-mailed to the agent.
- ❖ The signer for the lienholder must present documentation from the lienholder authorizing the signer (by name) to sign the form releasing liens on behalf of the lienholder.
- ❖ The signer for the lienholder must present proof of identification to verify identity.
- ❖ If an employee of the online dealer auction, PIADA or PAA is designated as an agent of the lienholder, a Power of Attorney from the lienholder is required. A photocopy of the Power of Attorney must be attached to this application.

Issuance of Title

- ❖ Upon completion of the form, a title is to be printed online immediately and given directly to the representative of the dealer who is named on the title as the vehicle owner.
- ❖ The representative of the dealer/owner must present documentation from the dealership, authorizing the representative (by name) to take possession of the title from the agent.
- ❖ The representative of the dealer/owner must present proof of identification to verify identity.
- ❖ The agent processing the title using this form may not be the same person signing for the lienholder using a Power of Attorney.

Documentation

- ❖ Agents must maintain copies of the following documentation, along with a copy of the completed Form MV-38A, in their on-site agent files:
 1. Copy of the lienholder's authorization letter
 2. Copy of the dealer/owner's authorization letter
 3. Copy of ID presented by lienholder's representative
 4. Copy of ID presented by dealership's representative
 5. Copy of Power of Attorney, if applicable
