Applicant must be 18 years of age and have a valid operator's license for each class of vehicle they intend to inspect. Applicant must also complete a lecture course at an approved educational facility, pass a written test and satisfactorily perform a complete inspection of a vehicle. Upon <u>successful</u> completion of these courses, you will receive your certified safety inspection certification card in approximately 6 to 8 weeks from the date your class ended. The school has 35 days from the class ending date to submit the paperwork for processing. You may not begin inspecting until you receive your certification card.

DRIVER LICENSE INFORMATION

- 1. Probationary License (PL)
- 2. Occupational Limited License (LL)
- 3. Ignition Interlock License (II)
- 4. Out-of-State License (if state does not border Pennsylvania)

OUT-OF-STATE DRIVER LICENSE INFORMATION

If a student lives out-of-state, they must provide their out-of-state address and driver's license information. (A Pennsylvania address may only be listed by a Pennsylvania resident.) A copy of the student's out-of-state driver's license must be attached to this form.

If they are a Pennsylvania resident, and they still possess an out-of-state driver's license, they must surrender their out-of-state driver's license and obtain a Pennsylvania Driver's License.
