

# Inspection Station & Inspector Violations Definitions Listing



Violation	Definition
Discontinuance of Business	Failure to report discontinuance of business.
Failure to Affix	Failure to affix certificate of inspection immediately upon successful completion of the inspection.
Inspector has violated or failed to comply with Title 75 Chapter 47 and/or Title 67 Pa. Code Chapter 175	The Inspector has improperly conducted inspections or has violated or failed to comply with the provisions of Title 75 Chapter 47 (relating to Vehicle Code) or 67 Pa. Code Chapter 175 (relating to Vehicle Equipment and Inspection Regulations)
Station has violated or failed to comply with Title 75 Chapter 47 and/or Title 67 Pa. Code Chapter 175	Failure of station to conduct the business of the official inspection station honestly and in the best interests of this Commonwealth, in violation of the requirements of Title 75 Chapter 47 and Title 67 Pa. Code Section 175.29(a).
Failure to Give Receipt	Failure to give a written receipt or work order to customer, or to list required information on work order.
Failure to Give Test Printout	Failure to make emission inspection test printout available to customer.
Failure to Notify	Failure to notify the Department of changes of ownership, location or other changes affecting an official inspection station.
Failure to Produce	Failure to produce records upon demand by Department quality assurance officer or other authorized Commonwealth representative or agent.
Failure to Verify	Failure to verify registration, title, manufacturer's statement of origin, financial responsibility information, or inspecting a vehicle with an expired registration or when valid proof of financial responsibility has not been submitted.
Faulty	Faulty inspection of equipment or parts.

Fraud	Fraudulent record keeping.
Furnish	Furnish, lend, give, sell or receive a certificate of inspection without inspection.
Improper Assign	Improper assigning of certificate of inspection.
Improper Use	Improper use of emission inspector certification.
Inspect by Expired Certification	Inspection by emission inspector with expired inspector certification.
Inspect by Suspended Driver's License	Inspection by emission inspector with suspended, revoked, cancelled, expired or recalled vehicle operating privilege.
Inspect by Uncertified	Inspection by uncertified inspector.
Inspect More Vehicles Per Hour	Inspecting more subject vehicles per hour per emission inspection inspector than permitted by § 177.408(g) and/or inspecting more than three motorcycles or two other vehicles per hour.
Issuance	Issuance or possession of altered, forged, stolen or counterfeit certificate of emission inspection.
Repairs Without Authorization	Performing repairs for the purpose of passing an inspection without vehicle owner authorization.
Required Tools	Missing or broken tools.
Sticker Security	Improper security of certificate of inspection.
Unclean Area	Unclean inspection area.
Unnecessary Repairs	Requiring or indicating unnecessary repairs for purpose of inspection.
