

# **Online Registration Program Reconstructed/Flood Vehicle Processing Guide**



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## 1.0 OVERVIEW OF PROJECT

### 1.1 Overview

PennDOT's Online Registration Program (OLRP) Agents/Dealers have the ability to process reconstructed, flood, and reconstructed flood branded titles online. Online Agents will use the OLRP Integrators system to title and register these three types of branded titles; **all other branded title work and out-of-state (OOS) reconstructed work must still be processed by PennDOT.**

PennDOT may, at its sole discretion, deny approval of an online agents request to process reconstructed transactions and suspend or revoke an online agents ability to process reconstructed title work if the online agent fails to maintain a quality rating of **98%** percent or greater.

### 1.2 Assumptions & Facts

1. All current OLRP financial deposits will be used.
2. The current OLRP title release date schedule will be used.
3. All available reconstructed vehicle processing must be done using the reconstructed transactions through the Integrators system.
4. The Integrator's front-end processing uses the reconstructed transaction types and cash drawers to access the reconstructed part of the OLRP Gatekeeper system.
5. The fee accounting for this process will use the existing fee codes along with their respective fees.

## 2.0 INTRODUCTION

Business Partners have the ability to electronically process branded Pennsylvania titles by using an enhanced version of the MV01 transaction via the OLRP system.

The following three title brands will be the only types allowed to be processed via the OLRP system:

- Reconstructed (Title Brand – R)
- Flood (Title Brand – W)
- Reconstructed Flood (Title Brand – B)

The following conditions will apply to processing branded titles:

- Form 907A issued by the State of New York is not an acceptable proof of ownership.
- Any Title or Certificate of Salvage stamped export only is not to be processed.
- Any out-of-state title or salvage certificate with a brand or adding a brand will continue to be processed by PennDOT.
- Any PA title being transferred that needs a brand added other than the three listed above will continue to be processed by PennDOT.
- A PA title with existing brands can be transferred using this online system. The existing brands will transfer with the title along with the addition of the reconstructed and/or flood brand.



The following scenarios must be processed by PennDOT:

- Any title branded as formerly abandon
- Any title requiring the issuance of a Vehicle Identification Number (VIN) or replacement VIN
- Any title requiring a change to the Gross Vehicle Weight Rating (GVWR)
- Any out-of-state title or salvage certificate
- Salvage certificates that indicate the vehicle is to be used for parts only; is not suitable to be rebuilt or titled; or is not designed, constructed or intended for use on public roadways are not acceptable (i.e., certificate of destruction, nonrepairable certificate or, off road use only)

The following brand changes are allowed:

1. R (Reconstructed) to B (Reconstructed Flood)
2. W (Flood) to B (Reconstructed Flood)
3. If a flood only vehicle is presented for processing, an acceptable appraisal report must accompany the application. When you reach the screen to confirm NMVTIS information, instead of a Y enter an A for appraisal and fill in the dollar amounts from the appraisal report.

If the title already contains a W brand for flood, you can process normally. If there is no appraisal report the title must be branded reconstructed/flood. The appraisal report must include the appraiser's name, license number, signature, vehicle identification number (VIN), actual cash value of the vehicle and level of damage (in dollars). Failure to include an acceptable appraisal report will result in the issuance of a reconstructed brand in addition to the flood brand.

The following brand changes are NOT allowed:

1. B (Reconstructed Flood) to R (Reconstructed)
2. B (Reconstructed Flood) to W (Flood)
3. R (Reconstructed) to W (Flood)
4. W (Flood) to R (Reconstructed)

## 2.1 MV01 – Title & Register Branded Vehicles

The enhanced MV01 conversation allows Business Partners to process title transactions relating to reconstructed and/or flood vehicle titles in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania by using the OLRP system.

The following transactions relating to applications for reconstructed and/or flood titles have been added to the current conversation functionality:

- Title Only Reconstructed Vehicle
- Title & Tag Reconstructed Vehicle
- Title & Transfer Tag with/without Renewal Reconstructed Vehicle
- Title & Transfer, Exchange, or Reissue Tag with/without Renew Reconstructed Vehicle
- (Re)Assignment of Title Only Reconstructed Vehicle



- Reassign Title & Tag Reconstructed Vehicle
- Reassign Title & Transfer with/without Renew Tag Reconstructed Vehicle
- Reassign Title, Transfer, Exchange or Reissue with/without Renew Reconstructed Vehicle

**NOTE:** For a reconstructed title application required to be submitted and processed by PennDOT, an agent may not issue or transfer registration.

## 2.2 Required Fields

The fields needed to complete the reconstructed and/or flood version of a MV01 transaction will be the same as:

- Regular title only
- Title & tag
- Title & transfer tag with/without renew
- Title & transfer, exchange, or reissue tag with/without renewal
- (Re)Assignment of title only
- Reassign title & tag
- Reassign title & transfer tag with/without renew
- Reassign title, transfer, exchange, or reissue tag with/without renewal

With the addition of the required fields listed below, these fields are new fields to the OLRP system and are only to be used in conjunction with the processing of [Form MV-426B](#).

- ENHANCED INSPECTION STATION NUMBER – Operators will enter the Enhanced Inspection Station number from [Form MV-426B](#) to determine if the station is authorized to perform enhanced vehicle safety inspections.
- ENHANCED VEHICLE SAFETY INSPECTOR NUMBER (Mechanic Number) – Operators will enter the Enhanced Vehicle Safety Inspector number from [Form MV-426B](#) to determine if the inspector is authorized to perform enhanced vehicle safety inspections.
- CERTIFIED DOCUMENT REVIEWER NUMBER – Operators will enter the Certified Document Reviewer number from [Form MV-426B](#) to determine if the Reviewer is authorized to perform document assembly/review for enhanced vehicle safety inspections. **NOTE:** The Reviewer may be the same person as the Inspector mentioned above. In this case, the number will be entered in both fields.
- TITLE BRAND(S) AUTHORIZED – Operators will enter the title brand(s) authorized by the Certified Document Reviewer. Certified Document Reviewers will indicate on [Form MV-426B](#) if online processing is authorized.

If any of the above verifications fail, the operator should contact the Special Services Unit (SSU) Unit at 717-705-6991 or OLRecon@pa.gov for guidance. In some cases, an authorization number may be provided to allow processing of the application to continue. If an authorization number is provided, a problem report is required. The problem report should be attached to the application prior to being forwarded to PennDOT.



### 3.0 MV-426B Examination and Data Verification

[Form MV-426B](#) shall be examined prior to processing a title. The following fields should be reviewed on [Form MV-426B](#):

- Confirm that an obsolete version of [Form MV-426B](#) has not been completed. Only the most current version of [Form MV-426B](#) found on PennDOT's website is valid. Customers presenting an obsolete version of [Form MV-426B](#) should be advised to have a new form completed. [Form MV-426B](#) can be found at [www.pa.gov/dmv](http://www.pa.gov/dmv).
- Confirm that the applicant name in Section A matches the applicant name in Section H.
- Confirm that the appropriate block is checked in Section B
- Confirm that the appropriate block(s) are checked in Section C.
- Confirm that half of an inspection sticker is affixed to Section D.
- Confirm that neither of the check blocks in Section D are checked (indicating that the application must be processed by PennDOT).
- Confirm that the enhanced vehicle safety inspector completed and signed Section D.
- If applicable confirm Section E is completed including the date and signature of Inspector.
- Confirm appropriate block(s) are checked in Section F.
- Verify all fees are captured in Section G.
- Confirm that the applicant has completed and signed in Section H.
- Confirm that the enhanced vehicle safety inspector has completed and signed in Section H.
- Confirm that the certified document reviewer has completed and signed in Section H. This includes the certified document reviewer's signature for each title brand check block indicated. **NOTE:** The certified document reviewer and the enhanced vehicle safety inspector may be the same person.
- Confirm that the certified document reviewer has authorized online processing by their signature in Section H.

All supporting documentation submitted with [Form MV-426B](#) shall be examined prior to processing a title. **NOTE:** Any supporting documentation, with the exception of the proof of ownership (title/salvage certificate), that is smaller than 8 ½" X 11" must be securely affixed (taped) to an 8 ½" X 11" sheet of paper by the enhanced inspection station personnel prior to submission for processing. The following items shall be reviewed for completeness:

- Confirm that a Pennsylvania Certificate of Title or Salvage Certificate is present and properly assigned/reassigned. Salvage certificates that indicate the vehicle is to be used for parts only; is not suitable to be rebuilt or titled; or is not designed, constructed or intended for use on public roadways are not acceptable (i.e., certificate of destruction, non-repairable certificate or, off road use only).



- o If the applicant used components from another vehicle, a copy of the Certificate of Title or Salvage Certificate for the parts vehicle may also be attached to [Form MV-426B](#) in lieu of an invoice or receipt. This should not be confused with the Certificate of Title or Salvage Certificate for the vehicle to be issued a branded title.
- Confirm that Form MV-1 (Application for Certificate of Title) is completed if the applicant's name does not currently appear on the face of the certificate of title or salvage certificate or if a co-owner is to be dropped or added on the new title.
- Color photographs of the vehicle showing the front, rear, left and right sides. (No angled shots). Photographs must be signed and dated by the **enhanced vehicle safety inspector and taken with the inspection station in the background**. Additional photographs may be required for mobile homes, motor homes, and collectible vehicles. Mobile home photographs do not have to be signed by an enhanced vehicle safety inspector. **NOTE:** Original signatures are required. Stamped signatures are not permitted. Additionally, as enhanced inspection stations sign the new enhanced inspection station contract with the Department, Business Partners will begin to see photos that have a date and time stamp as well as a 5th photograph of the VIN plate. This is acceptable for purposes of processing the application.

All applicable fees and sales tax must be paid. **NOTE:** Sales tax is not required to be paid to PennDOT with the sale of a used mobile home. Payments should follow the OLRP Fee Deposit requirements.



## 4.0 Document Preparation

Documents will be prepared/imaged using current business rules/practices. No documents are to be discarded.

### 4.1 Document Organization

Documents included with [Form MV-426B](#) are to be ordered by the Certified Document Reviewer prior to submission of the application for processing. Operators will add their processing documentation to the front of the [MV-426B](#) packet after processing is completed. The Imaging Unit should ensure the documents are in the proper order. The OLRP documents for an MV01 transaction (Applicant Summary) should be in the standard order followed by:

- [Form MV-426B](#)
- Form MV-1 (if the applicant's name does not appear on the Certificate of Title or Salvage Certificate or if a prior co-owner is to be dropped on the new title)
- Certificate of Title or Salvage Certificate

Any remaining documents do not have to be in a specific order for imaging.

### 4.2 Document Submission to PennDOT

Paperwork for [MV-426B](#) transactions shall be kept separate from the paperwork for other title transactions. **All processed reconstructed transaction paperwork shall be delivered to your Integrator for review and scanning as soon as possible but no later than 10 day from the processing date.**

### 4.3 Problem Reporting

In addition to current business rules, problem reports will be submitted for all [MV-426B](#) applications requiring an authorization number in lieu of the enhanced vehicle safety inspection station number, enhanced vehicle safety inspector number, or certified document reviewer number. Problem Reports are provided to Online Agents and Dealers from your Integrator.

When submitting a problem report for a branded vehicle, please forward all documents related to the transaction. If all documents required are not available at the time the problem is reported, there may not be sufficient documentation to make the required correction within the tanking period. These types of problem reports may not be able to be completed without an additional fee.

**NOTE:** An individual who has not been paid the replacement value for the recovered theft vehicle and has not received a certificate of salvage, may use their existing certificate of title without applying for a new certificate of title.

**Applicant Information** - All applicant information must be entered exactly as it is to appear on the certificate of title. A Pennsylvania Certificate of Title will only be issued to a physical address; you may not use a post office box address alone or an out-of-state address. If the certificate of title or salvage certificate was previously issued to co-owners, both owners must sign Form MV-426B or Form MV-1, "Application for Certificate of Title," must be completed to change the ownership on the new title. All out-of-state proof of ownership documents must be accompanied by a completed Form MV-1. **NOTE:** Individuals should list their PA Driver's License (PA DL) or Photo ID# in the space provided. Businesses should list their Business ID# (Bus. ID), where indicated (i.e. E.I.N.).

**Vehicle Type** - If the vehicle type is a mobile home, "mobile home" should be specified in the "Other" block. Mobile homes do not need to be inspected by an enhanced vehicle safety inspector, and an inspection sticker does not need to be affixed to Form MV-426B. A detailed description of how the mobile home was reconstructed must be attached to your application along with interior and exterior photographs. Your application must be signed by a certified document reviewer and forwarded to PennDOT for processing.

Previously abandoned vehicles and vehicles that were impounded and subsequently sold are considered reconstructed vehicles. Check "Other" in the Vehicle Type block, provide an explanation of how the vehicle was acquired and the level of damage, if any.

**Weight Certification** - The weight certification for trucks, truck-tractors and trailers must be completed by a certified enhanced vehicle safety inspector if the correct weight(s) do not appear on the vehicle's certificate of title or salvage certificate (such as unladen weight, gross vehicle weight rating or gross combination weight rating). A weight slip for the unladen (empty) weight must be attached if the correct unladen weight does not appear on the certificate of title or salvage certificate. It is not necessary to complete the weight certification in order to change the registered gross weight of a vehicle. Previously titled vehicles that have been altered to raise or lower the gross vehicle weight rating (GVWR) must be certified by the vehicle manufacturer. A new VIN-specific weight certification decal must be issued for the vehicle by the manufacturer. This label must be affixed to the left (driver's side) door jamb or door latch post.

**Components Repaired/Replaced** - With the exception of out-of-state vehicles described below, all major components that have been replaced or repaired should be indicated on the application. For all items replaced, you must provide a receipt or invoice or a copy of the Pennsylvania Certificate of Title or Salvage Certificate for another vehicle (which you own) from which parts were taken. It is not necessary to attach receipts for repaired components (such as labor for body work). Repair estimates may be used as receipts if they are marked "Paid" and signed and dated by someone authorized by the repair facility to do so. Repair estimates that are not marked "Paid" or those that are not signed and dated are not acceptable for use as receipts.

If the vehicle is coming to Pennsylvania on an out-of-state title that has already been branded (e.g., rebuilt salvage, reconstructed, previously salvaged, etc.), you are not required to document components repaired/replaced, nor provide receipts for parts replaced. Vehicles coming to Pennsylvania on a branded out-of-state title are permitted to obtain a temporary Pennsylvania registration and the vehicle may be operated while Form MV-426B is being processed. If a truck cab is replaced, [Form MV-41, "Application for Correction of Vehicle Record or Verification of Vehicle Identification Number."](#) must be attached to Form MV-426B to request a state replacement VIN Plate. Under Section C (Application for State Replacement VIN Plate), check "Other" and indicate the cab was replaced. The VIN specified on [Form MV-41](#) should be the VIN that appears on the frame of the vehicle (not the VIN displayed on the replacement cab). **NOTE:** [Form MV-41](#) and the corresponding Form Form MV-426B must be submitted to PennDOT for processing.

When an odometer is repaired or replaced, the mileage indicated must remain the same as before the repair or replacement. If the odometer is incapable of registering the same mileage as before the repair or replacement, the odometer must be adjusted to read zero (0) and a notice in writing must be attached to the left door frame of the vehicle specifying the mileage prior to repair or replacement of the odometer and the date on which it was repaired or replaced.

Fee calculations should be completed and signed by the certified document reviewer. For a listing of current registration fees, please refer to [Form MV-70S, "Bureau of Motor Vehicles Schedule of Fees."](#) found on our website at [www.pa.gov/dmv](http://www.pa.gov/dmv). All checks or money orders should be made payable to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

Authorized Signatures - Signatures must be present for the applicant, enhanced vehicle safety inspector (not required for mobile homes) and certified document reviewer. If the vehicle is to be titled in the name of a business, the application must be signed by an owner or corporate officer of the business.

Should you choose to personalize your registration plate, please complete and attach [Form MV-904, "Application for Personalized, Amateur Radio Operator, or Press Photographer Registration Plate."](#) to this application. There is an additional fee required with personalization requests. **NOTE:** If requesting your Street Rod registration plate to be personalized, complete and attach [Form MV-904SR, "Application for Personalized Street Rod Registration Plate."](#) to this application.

#### Application Attachment Checklist

- Proof of ownership: Pennsylvania Certificate of Title; Pennsylvania Certificate of Salvage, certificate of salvage issued by another state or jurisdiction; certificate of title issued by another state or jurisdiction and indicating the vehicle was reconstructed in another state or jurisdiction; Manufacturer's Certificate of Origin or Statement of Origin (MCO/MSO) issued by a recognized manufacturer of vehicles. (**NOTE:** A MCO/MSO that indicates the vehicle is not intended for highway use (or similar designation) cannot be titled in Pennsylvania.) Specially constructed vehicles may have a bill of sale as acceptable proof of ownership (if no other ownership document exists).
- Unacceptable forms of proof of ownership include Form 907A issued by the state of New York, or any title, certificate of origin, statement of origin or certificate of salvage that indicates the vehicle is to be used for parts only; is not suitable to be rebuilt or titled or is not designed, constructed or intended for use on a public roadway. This includes statements of origin for all terrain vehicles (ATVs).
- Form MV-1, "Application for Certificate of Title," if the applicant's name does not currently appear on the face of the certificate of title or salvage certificate or if a co-owner is to be removed from the new title record.
- Appraisal report for flood or recovered theft vehicles where the damage does not exceed the replacement value of the vehicle. An acceptable appraisal report must contain the name and signature of the licensed appraiser; the appraiser's license number; the VIN of the vehicle appraised; the level of damage (in dollars); and the actual cash value of the vehicle (prior to flood or theft). **NOTE:** If the owner is a self-insurer, the assessment of damage must be completed by a licensed physical damage appraiser who is not affiliated with or employed by the self-insurer.
- A bill of sale if the applicant's name is not displayed on the face of the certificate of title or salvage certificate (not required for dealers who are sales tax exempt). If a salvaged vehicle was reassigned free of charge, [Form MV-13ST, "Affidavit of Gift,"](#) may be submitted in lieu of a bill of sale. An acceptable bill of sale includes: the seller's name; seller's signature; buyer's name; Vehicle Identification Number (VIN); date of sale; purchase price; and if applicable, a statement from the seller indicating the vehicle was already completed at the time of purchase and no branded title was obtained by the seller. If this information does not appear on the bill of sale, a separate statement must be signed by the seller, notarized and contain the VIN of the vehicle.
- A power of attorney for any person signing on behalf of a purchaser or seller, if applicable. **NOTE:** An "agent" signing on behalf of an employer is not required to attach a power of attorney.
- Retention (buy-back) letter from insurance company if vehicle was totaled and retained by the applicant for the purpose of retitling it. This letter (on the insurance company or insurance agent's letterhead) should indicate the amount deducted from the insurance pay-off (settlement) to allow the insured to retain the vehicle.
- Copies of all receipts for all components replaced as indicated on Form MV-426B (if required). If you indicate a component was taken from another vehicle, a copy of the salvage certificate or title (in your name) for the parts vehicle must be attached in lieu of a receipt. **NOTE:** Only business entities (dealers, rebuilders, etc.) titling the vehicle in the business name may claim parts used in the reconstruction were taken from existing inventory, and therefore, no receipts are needed. If a dealer or rebuilder reconstructed a vehicle for the applicant, the parts used to complete the vehicle may be listed on the bill of sale.



- A weight slip if the correct unladen weight of a truck, trailer or truck-tractor is not listed on the certificate of title or salvage.
- A detailed description on separate 8 ½" X 11" paper for specially constructed, collectible, modified vehicles and street rods indicating how the vehicle was configured and assembled.
- Photographs of the vehicle showing the front, rear, left and right sides. Photographs must be signed/dated by the enhanced vehicle safety inspector. Additional photographs may be required for mobile homes, motor homes and collectible vehicles. Mobile home photographs do not have to be signed by an enhanced vehicle safety inspector.
- All applicable fees. Checks and/or money orders should be made payable to Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
- Any unpaid sales tax for vehicle purchase, insurance buy-back (retention) or any items purchased without tax collected such as online purchases.

If the vehicle was purchased outside Pennsylvania within the previous six (6) months, the applicant must show proof of sales tax paid in the form of a sales tax receipt, notarized bill of sale or notarized letter from the seller indicating the amount of sales tax paid. Repair estimates that are not marked "Paid" or those that are not signed and dated are not acceptable for use as receipts.

If the vehicle is coming to Pennsylvania on an out-of-state title that has already been branded (e.g., rebuilt salvage, reconstructed, previously salvaged, etc.), the customer is not required to document components repaired/replaced, nor provide receipts for parts replaced. Vehicles coming to Pennsylvania on a branded out-of-state title must still be processed by PennDOT. Vehicles coming to Pennsylvania on a branded out-of-state title are permitted to obtain a temporary Pennsylvania registration and the vehicle may be operated while [Form MV-426B](#) is being processed.

If the vehicle is coming to Pennsylvania on an out-of-state salvage certificate, receipts must be present and comply with all requirements under the [Form MV-426B](#) process. **NOTE:** These vehicles may not be operated while [Form MV-426B](#) is being processed by PennDOT. Please be



aware that if the agent is unable to process the reconstructed title online and has to submit the work to PennDOT for processing, the agent is not permitted to issue temporary registration. The reconstructed title must be processed before any registration can be issued for this vehicle.

If a truck cab is replaced, [Form MV-41, "Application for Correction of Vehicle Record or Verification of Vehicle Identification Number,"](#) must be attached to [Form MV-426B](#) to request a state replacement VIN Plate. Under Section C (Application for State Replacement VIN Plate), check "Other" and indicate the cab was replaced. The VIN specified on [Form MV-41](#) should be the VIN that appears on the frame of the vehicle (not the VIN displayed on the replacement cab). **NOTE:** [Form MV-41](#) and the corresponding [Form MV-426B](#) must be submitted to PennDOT for processing.

When an odometer is repaired, or replaced, the mileage indicated must remain the same as before the repair or replacement. If the odometer is incapable of registering the same mileage as before the repair or replacement, the odometer must be adjusted to read zero (0) and a notice in writing must be attached to the left door frame of the vehicle specifying the mileage prior to repair or replacement of the odometer and the date on which it was repaired or replaced.

### Application Attachment Checklist

- Proof of ownership: Pennsylvania Certificate of Title; Pennsylvania Certificate of Salvage, certificate of salvage issued by another state or jurisdiction; certificate of title issued by another state or jurisdiction and indicating the vehicle was reconstructed in another state or jurisdiction; Manufacturer's Certificate of Origin or Statement of Origin (MCO/MSO) issued by a recognized manufacturer of vehicles. (**NOTE:** A MCO/MSO that indicates the vehicle is not intended for highway use (or similar designation) cannot be titled in Pennsylvania.) Specially constructed vehicles may have a bill of sale as acceptable proof of ownership (if no other ownership document exists).
- Unacceptable forms of proof of ownership include Form 907A issued by the state of New York, or any title, certificate of origin, statement of origin or certificate of salvage that indicates the vehicle is to be used for parts only; is not suitable to be rebuilt or titled or is not designed, constructed or intended for use on a public roadway. This includes statements of origin for all terrain vehicles (ATVs).
- Form MV-1, "Application for Certificate of Title," if the applicant's name does not currently appear on the face of the certificate of title or salvage certificate or if a co-owner is to be removed from the new title record.
- Appraisal report for flood or recovered theft vehicles where the damage does not exceed the replacement value of the vehicle. An acceptable appraisal report must contain the name and signature of the licensed appraiser; the appraiser's license number; the VIN of the vehicle appraised; the level of damage (in dollars); and the actual cash value of the vehicle (prior to flood or theft). **NOTE:** If the owner is a self-insurer, the assessment of damage must be completed by a licensed physical damage appraiser who is not affiliated with or employed by the self-insurer.
- A bill of sale if the applicant's name is not displayed on the face of the certificate of title or salvage certificate (not required for dealers who are sales tax exempt). If a salvaged vehicle was reassigned free of charge, [Form MV-13ST, "Affidavit of Gift,"](#) may be submitted in lieu of a bill of sale. An acceptable bill of sale includes: the seller's name; seller's signature; buyer's name; Vehicle Identification Number (VIN); date of sale; purchase price; and if applicable, a statement from the seller indicating the vehicle was already completed at the time of purchase and no branded title was obtained by the seller. If this information does not appear on the bill of sale, a separate statement must be signed by the seller, notarized and contain the VIN of the vehicle.
- A power of attorney for any person signing on behalf of a purchaser or seller, if applicable. **NOTE:** An "agent" signing on behalf of an employer is not required to attach a power of attorney.
- Retention (buy-back) letter from insurance company if vehicle was totaled and retained by the applicant for the purpose of retitling it. This letter (on the insurance company or insurance agent's letterhead) should indicate the amount deducted from the insurance pay-off (settlement) to allow the insured to retain the vehicle.
- Copies of all receipts for all components replaced as indicated on [Form MV-426B](#) (if required). If you indicate a component was taken from another vehicle, a copy of the salvage certificate or title (in your name) for the parts vehicle must be attached in lieu of a receipt. **NOTE:** Only business entities (dealers, rebuilders, etc.) titling the vehicle in the business name may claim parts used in the reconstruction were taken from existing inventory, and therefore, no receipts are needed. If a dealer or rebuilder reconstructed a vehicle for the applicant, the parts used to complete the vehicle may be listed on the bill of sale.
- A weight slip if the correct unladen weight of a truck, trailer or truck-tractor is not listed on the certificate of title or salvage.
- A detailed description on separate 8 ½" X 11" paper for specially constructed, collectible, modified vehicles and street rods indicating how the vehicle was configured and assembled.
- Photographs of the vehicle showing the front, rear, left and right sides. Photographs must be signed/dated by the enhanced vehicle safety inspector. Additional photographs may be required for mobile homes, motor homes and collectible vehicles. Mobile home photographs do not have to be signed by an enhanced vehicle safety inspector.
- All applicable fees. Checks and/or money orders should be made payable to Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
- Any unpaid sales tax for vehicle purchase, insurance buy-back (retention) or any items purchased without tax collected such as online purchases.  
If the vehicle was purchased outside Pennsylvania within the previous six (6) months, the applicant must show proof of sales tax paid in the form of a sales tax receipt, notarized bill of sale or notarized letter from the seller indicating the amount of sales tax paid. Refer to [Form REV-227, "Pennsylvania Sales and Use Tax Credit Chart,"](#) to determine if you may claim a tax credit for sales tax paid in another state. This chart can be found on the Department of Revenue website at [www.revenue.pa.gov](http://www.revenue.pa.gov). **NOTE:** Applicants exempt from Pennsylvania sales tax will list the appropriate Sales Tax Exemption reason code in Sections 1A and/or 1B. (See exemption codes listed on the reverse side of Form MV-1.)  
Sales tax is not required to be paid to PennDOT in connection with the sale of a used mobile home, regardless of whether it is permanently affixed or relocated.
- [Form MV-41, "Application for Correction of Vehicle Record or Verification of Vehicle Identification Number,"](#) if a Pennsylvania replacement Vehicle Identification Number (VIN) plate is required. **NOTE:** [Form MV-41](#) and the corresponding [Form MV-426B](#) must be submitted to PennDOT for processing.

**Q1. What title brands are able to be processed through the Online Registration Program (OLRP)?**

Reconstructed (Title Brand – R)  
Flood (Title Brand – W)  
Reconstructed Flood (Title Brand – B)

**Q2. What are the four scenarios in which an OLRP participant is unable to process the transaction and the documentation must be forwarded to PennDOT for processing?**

Any title branded as formerly abandon.  
Any title requiring the issuance of a VIN or replacement VIN  
Any title requiring a change to the GVWR  
Any out-of-state title or salvage certificate

**Q3. Who is able to perform an enhanced vehicle safety inspection?**

Only those safety inspection stations appointed and under contract with PennDOT as an Enhanced Vehicle Safety Inspection Station, may perform inspections for compliance with all applicable equipment and inspection regulations for the purpose of titling the vehicle in Pennsylvania on the following vehicles: reconstructed, flood, specially constructed, recovered theft, collectible, modified vehicles and street rods.

**Q4. If a new Vehicle Identification Number (VIN) is needed, what additional forms are required to be submitted?**

[Form MV-41, "Application for Correction of Vehicle Record or Verification of Vehicle Identification Number,"](#) must be attached to [Form MV-426B](#) to request a state replacement VIN Plate.

**Q5. (True or False) I own an enhanced inspection station and I need to have an enhanced inspection completed on a vehicle that I own. Is it ok for my employee to perform the enhance inspection?**

False. The vehicle owner or an employee of the vehicle owner shall not be the inspecting mechanic. If the vehicle owner/applicant is the enhanced inspector or if the enhanced inspector is an employee of the owner/applicant, you cannot process the reconstructed title application. You should advise the applicant they must take the vehicle to another enhanced inspector.



**Q6. When reconstructing a vehicle, is it ok to use parts from another vehicle without having a receipt?**

If the applicant indicates a component was taken from another vehicle they own, a copy of the salvage certificate or title (in the name of the applicant) for the parts vehicle must be attached in lieu of a receipt.

NOTE: Only business entities (dealers, rebuilders, etc.) titling the vehicle in the business name may claim parts used in the reconstruction were taken from existing inventory, and therefore, no receipts are needed. If a dealer or rebuilder reconstructed a vehicle for the applicant, the parts used to complete the vehicle may be listed on the bill of sale in lieu of a receipt for the part.

**Q7. Am I able to issue a temporary registration plate to an out-of-state (OOS) vehicle that is salvaged?**

No. Agents are not able to issue registration to a salvage vehicle. The vehicle paperwork must be submitted to PennDOT for processing and issuance of registration materials.
