PennDOT Announces Mercer County Maintenance Schedule

Oil City, PA – Mercer County Maintenance Manager Zach Miles today announced the following county maintenance schedule for the week of April 28, 2025 for roadways maintained by the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT).

PennDOT crews at facilities throughout District 1, which includes Crawford, Erie, Forest, Mercer, Venango and Warren counties, complete a large scope of work on more than 3,600 miles of roadway throughout the year to help provide an efficient transportation system. All work is weather dependent.
