PennDOT Mifflin County Maintenance Work Schedule for the Week of April 21

Clearfield, PA – The Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT) announced the following schedule of maintenance activities in Mifflin County the week of April 21. PennDOT performs year-round maintenance in its mission to provide a safe, efficient transportation system, and the scope of work in Mifflin County for the coming week is as follows:

Bridge Maintenance & Cleaning

- Route 4013 (Ferguson Valley Road) between Strodes Run Road in Granville
 Township and Ridge View Drive in Derry Township. Monday, April 21, through
 Wednesday, April 23. This work takes place off the roadway and has minimal, if
 any, traffic impact, however PennDOT still urges drivers to exercise caution when
 passing crews working along the shoulder.
- Route 3014 (John Street) at a pair of bridges spanning the Juniata River in McVeytown Borough and Bratton Township. Thursday, April 24. This work takes place off the roadway and has minimal, if any, traffic impact, however PennDOT still urges drivers to exercise caution when passing crews working along the shoulder.
- Route 3017 (Ferguson Valley Road) between Little Greenbriar and Mount Hope roads. Friday, April 25. This work takes place off the roadway and has minimal, if any, traffic impact, however PennDOT still urges drivers to exercise caution when passing crews working along the shoulder.

Pennsylvania has some of the oldest bridges in the country, with an age of more than 50 years on average. Preventive maintenance is vital in extending the life of the structures. As such, PennDOT maintenance crews perform some bridge deck patching and structural repairs.

Crack Seal & Hot Pour Mastic

 Route 4006 (Back Mountain Road) between Route 305 in Union Township and Route 1005 (Old U.S. 322 Highway) in Armagh Township. Monday, April 21, through Friday, April 25. Flaggers in the roadway will provide traffic control during daylight hours. Crack sealing and hot pour mastic operations prevent water intrusion from seeping through cracks or joints in an asphalt road, which can lead to potholes and pavement breakup. They are proactive preventive maintenance strategies to prevent water from entering the roadways and accelerating the formation of potholes and other failures.

Sweeping

- Route 22 (William Penn Highway) westbound between the Juniata-Mifflin County line in Derry Township and Caldwell Hill Road in Granville Township. Monday, April 21, through Wednesday, April 23. Flaggers in the roadway will provide traffic control. PennDOT shadow vehicles will be in the roadway for this continuously moving operation that drivers may pass via the open lane providing they do so cautiously and in the absence of oncoming traffic in the opposing lane.
- Route 322 westbound between the Burnham-Yeagertown interchange and the Centre-Mifflin County line. Thursday, April 24, and Friday, April 25. PennDOT shadow vehicles will be in the roadway for this continuously moving operation that drivers may pass via the open lane providing they do so cautiously and in the absence of oncoming traffic in the opposing lane.

Sweeping utilizes a mechanical broom attachment on a piece of mobile highway equipment used to remove loose debris from the roadway, improving safety and surface traction for motorists.

This schedule is subject to change due to weather conditions, emergencies, or other unforeseen interruptions.
