





Municipal Support


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PLANNING AMIDST ACCELERATING CHANGE


- The COVID-19 pandemic and its dramatic changes to transportation demand

- A contentious political environment and related societal division






PLANNING AMIDST ACCELERATING CHANGE

LRTP GOALS



Enhance safety and security for both motorized and non-motorized modes throughout Pennsylvania's transportation system.

Strengthen transportation mobility to meet the increasingly dynamic needs of Pennsylvania residents, businesses, and visitors.

Improve transportation access and equity throughout Pennsylvania.

Strengthen Pennsylvania transportation's resilience to climate change and other risks and reduce transportation's environmental impacts.

Improve the condition and performance of transportation assets

Structure transportation funding and finance approaches that allocate sufficient resources for system safety, maintenance, preservation, and improvement.

Align freight mobility with economic development and land use.

Advance project investments that enhance freight mobility.

Provide planning, data, and analytical tools for improved decision-making.

Improve multimodal freight transportation operations and safety.



SAMPLE ACTIONS AND INITIATIVES (FMP)

Develop statewide economic impact assessment tool.


Develop parameters and standards for a Pennsylvania core freight network.

Develop guidelines for industrial development standards addressing estimated freight generation rates by land use types.

Encourage the incorporation of requirements for truck parking and staging areas in zoning and land use development regulations for industrial sites.



LINKING LAND USE & TRANSPORTATION





FREIGHT-ORIENTED LAND USES

KEY LAND USE ISSUES

- Property ratables for municipal tax revenues: What is the highest and best use of the property?
- Limited land: What uses require (or benefit most from) specific location characteristics?
- **Economic impact:** "Primary" freight-intensive land uses tend to have higher economic impacts than "secondary" ones, due to generally higher value-added component and the need for more labor, and more skilled labor.
- Infrastructure impacts: Impact on transportation and utilities (e.g., water use for some manufacturing processes is a major issue).
- Environmental impacts: Noise, air quality, general quality of life.



KEY LAND USE ISSUES (CONT'D)

- Truck parking: Complex issue related to Federal hours-of-service rules, rest requirements, staging for deliveries, etc.
- Traffic congestion: Roadway capacity, truck turning radii, signal timing at major intersections, etc.
- Truck idling: Air quality and noise, especially near sensitive land uses (schools, hospitals, residential areas, etc.).
- Community impacts from trucks traveling through local neighborhoods.
- Historic buildings: Vibration impacts from heavy vehicles on adjacent streets.



LOCAL GOVERNMENT COLLABORATION - LRTP



Through state and local collaboration, identify new funding sources and revenue streams that allow for innovation, flexibility, and blending in implementation.



Work with local and county officials to inventory needed transportation improvements and costs by region and track costs/benefits to assess return on investment



Revisit and work with local governments on the feasibility of local bridge bundling programs



Within each state agencies and MPO/RPOs, identify the types of institutional knowledge that should be transferred to future staff members.



Infrastructure development with county planning, GIS departments, and EMAs



Cross-agency and inter-agency data standardization





LOCAL GOVERNMENT COLLABORATION - FMP



Refinement/expansion of Critical Urban and Critical Rural Freight Corridors





Identify and adopt changes to the MPC, local government ordinances and regulations, and state agency policies and regulations to keep pace with rapidly changing land use patterns



Discussions and collaboration with other state agencies related to planning and land use






Enhance ordinances for transportation and land use






PLAN IMPLEMENTATION AND GOVERNANCE


