Distracted Driving

In 2010, Paul Miller Jr. was tragically killed when a tractor-trailer driver became distracted while reaching for their phone and collided with Paul.

Beginning June 2026, under Paul Miller's Law, drivers can be pulled over and fined for holding their phone – including while stopped at a red light.


