Beaks

Warm blood

Backbones

ALL BIRDS ARE VERTEBRATES - THEY HAVE BACKBONES



Wings

ALL BIRDS HAVE WINGS, BUT NOT ALL BIRDS FLY



Feathers

BIRDS HAVE FEATHERS FOR FLIGHT, WARMTH, CAMOFLAGUE, AND DISPLAY



Two legs

BIRDS ONLY HAVE 2 LEGS FOR WALKING



Eggs

BIRDS LAY HARD-SHELLED EGGS OF ALL SIZES, SHAPES, COLORS, TEXTURES, AND PATTERNS
