Note that bird species are identified as SGCN for one or more focal seasons: breeding, migration and/or winter, as indicated, and hibernating bat species are SGCN in breeding and wintering seasons. (R) - Species for which Pennsylvania is responsible for $\geq 10\%$ of North American population or $\geq 25\%$ of North American range (i.e., Pennsylvania responsibility species). “New” - Species added as SGCN in 2025 that were not SGCN in the 2015-25 PA WAP. “Maintained” – Species retained as SGCN between 2015 and 2025 PA WAPs. **Totals: 858 SGCN; 86 birds, 21 mammals, 47 fishes, 19 amphibians, 18 reptiles, 667 invertebrates.**
