# Protect Yourself, Your Community, Your Dogs, Wildlife, and Backyard Birds from Bird Flu

## **Hunter and Trappers**

Watch for symptoms like fever, cough, sore throat, headache, muscle aches, eye redness or irritation, or breathing trouble for **10 days** after having contact with game.

## **Dogs Can Carry the Virus**

Seek veterinary care immediately if they show signs of being sick. Call ahead before seeing a health care provider or veterinarian to let them know about a possible bird flu exposure.
