FINAL ORDER

AND NOW, this 21st day of April, A.D. 1967, the above case having come up for public hearing before a Hearing Panel of the Pennsylvania Human Relations Commission, and the respondents, THOMAS PINTI and DOMENIC ROMEO, having waived the public hearing in accordance with Section 105.20 of the Commission's Regulations and having agreed that a Final Order shall be entered by the Commission, without making any findings of fact or conclusions of law, it is hereby

ORDERED, by the Pennsylvania Human Relations Commission

1. That the respondents, THOMAS PINTI and DOMENIC ROMEO, shall not, directly or indirectly, refuse, withhold from or deny to the complainant, to other Negroes, and to other persons because of their race, color, religious creed, ancestry or national origin, the accommodations, advantages, facilities or privileges of the Modern Barber Shop located at 119 North York Road, Willow Grove, Pennsylvania, or any other barber shop operated by the

respondents or either of them within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

- 2. That the respondents, THOMAS PINTI and DOMENIC ROMEO, shall take the following affirmative action which in the judgment of the Commission will effectuate the purposes of the Pennsylvania Human Relations Act:
 - a. Extend to the complainant and to all persons, without regard to their race, color, religious creed, ancestry or national origin full, equal and unsegregated accommodations, advantages, facilities and privileges at Modern Barber Shop in Willow Grove, Pennsylvania, and any other barber shop operated by the respondents or either of them within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania;
 - b. Instruct all of the respondents' employes, in writing, to serve Negroes entering Modern Barber Shop in Willow Grove, Penmsylvania, and any other barber shop operated by the respondents or either of them within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in the same manner as white customers. Copies of such written instructions signed by all of respondents' employes and acknowledging receipt and understanding thereof shall be transmitted to the Commission by the respondents;
 - c. Post and maintain in a conspicuous place at Modern

 Barber Shop in Willow Grove, Pennsylvania, where patrons entering
 the barber shop may easily see it, a copy of the Commission's

 poster, furnished by the Commission; and

d. Notify the Pennsylvania Human Relations Commission at its offices at No. 1401 Labor and Industry Building,
Harrisburg, Pennsylvania, 17120, in writing, within fifteen (15) days after service hereof as to the steps the respondents have taken to comply with this Final Order.
