

LEGAL CASE DISPOSITIONS

August 5, 2026

1. Pennsylvania Milk Board v. Lakeland Dairy Farm

License No. 10000648 (Hauler)

Docket No. CE-26-003

Violation: Defendant failed to file its Milk Hauler's Monthly Report and appropriate fee for December 2025, resulting in a violation of Section 552 of the Milk Marketing Law, 31 P.S. § 700j-552, and Section 150.53(b) of the Regulations of the Pennsylvania Milk Board, 7 Pa. Code § 150.53(b).

Disposition: Defendant executed a Consent Order in lieu of a hearing acknowledging the violation and agreed to pay a penalty of \$50.00.

2. Pennsylvania Milk Board v. Montena-Taranto Foods

License No. 10005345 (Dealer)

Docket Nos. CE-26-002 & CE-26-006

Violations: (a) Defendant failed to produce invoices and proof of payment by the date set by Board staff for all milk purchases from Menno Beiler and his affiliated entities for the months of January, February, and March, 2026.
(b) Defendant failed to timely file accurate Milk Dealer's monthly report for May, 2026.
(c) Defendant purchased milk from Menno Beiler in May, June and July, 2026.

Disposition: Defendant executed a Consent Order in lieu of a hearing acknowledging the violations. The Consent Order stipulates that the Defendant will not purchase milk from Menno Beiler and/or his current or any future entities. The Consent Order further states that the Defendant shall be issued a Provisional Milk Dealer's License. The Defendant agreed to pay a penalty of \$52,500.00.
