CONSENT ORDER

NOW, this 27th day of July, 2026, the parties to this proceeding, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Milk Board ("Board") and Montena-Taranto Foods ("Defendant"), agree as follows:

1. Defendant hereby waives its right to a hearing concerning the citations issued at the docket numbers set forth above, to an Order of the Board supported by findings of fact and conclusions of law based upon the record of such hearing, and to appeal this matter to a court of competent jurisdiction.
2. Defendant admits to the violation set forth in the Citation, Docket No. CE-26-002.
3. By way of further detail, Defendant admits that it failed to produce invoices and proof of payment by the date set by the Board for all milk purchased from Menno Beiler and his affiliated entities, including Simply Real Milk and Northumberland Dairies, for the months of January, February, and March 2026.
4. Defendant admits to the violation set forth in the second Citation, Docket No. CE-26-006.
5. Defendant admits that in May, June and July 2026, it purchased milk from Menno Beiler and his entities.
6. By entering into this Order, Defendant affirms that it will not purchase any milk from Menno Beiler and any of his current entities, including Simply Real Milk LLC, North Umlerland Dairies, Milk Marketing Services, and Montour Dairies, LLC.
7. Defendant affirms that it will similarly not purchase any milk from any entity Menno Beiler may establish in the future.

8. The Board incorporates by reference into this Order the injunction order of the Chester County Court of Common Pleas Docket No. 2026-02322-IR, which, in pertinent part, enjoined Menno Beiler from engaging in any and all milk dealing operations, including but not limited to purchasing milk from producers.
9. Contemporaneously with consideration of this Order, the Board will issue Montena-Taranto Foods, (License No. 10005345) a Provisional Milk Dealer License.
10. Defendant agrees to pay \$52,500.00 in resolution of this matter and in lieu of a hearing before the Board.
11. This Order shall be deemed adopted when approved by majority vote of the members of the Board.
