



## State Police Investigate Burglary in Allen Township

Allen Township, Northampton County – The Pennsylvania State Police (PSP) Troop M – Bethlehem Station is investigating a burglary that occurred on December 19, 2025, in Allen Township, Northampton County.

On Friday, December 19, 2025, at approximately 6:18 pm, Troopers were dispatched to a residence in the 200 block of Windsor Drive, Allen Township, Northampton County, for the report of a burglary. Upon investigation, it was determined the actor gained entry into the residence by forcing the sliding back door open. Once inside the residence, the actor stole watches from the house, that had a total value of \$20,000.00.



Troopers are requesting the publics assistance with identifying the above individual and above vehicle who were observed in the area of the burglary on the above date and time.
