Crash Synopsis:

This crash occurred at Lincoln Way E at its intersection with Falling Spring Rd, Guilford TWP, Franklin County, PA. Prior to this crash, Unit 1 was westbound on Lincoln Way E. Prior to this crash, Unit 2 was traveling westbound on Lincoln Way E. This crash occurred when Operator 1 stated she turned her attention from the road because her children were arguing in the back seat. Operator 1 explained that when she turned her attention to her children, she rear-ended Unit 2. Operator 1 stated she was at fault at the scene. Operator 2 stated he was stopped at the light, waiting to continue on Lincoln Way E, when he felt Unit 1 rear-end him.

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Unit 1 struck Unit 2 with its 12 o'clock position striking Unit 2's 6 o'clock. Both Units remained drivable from the scene. Operator 1 and 2, along with all passengers, were uninjured in this crash. Both Unit 1 and 2 sustained minor but functional damage. Both operators exchanged information without incident.

Crash Synopsis:

This crash occurred as Unit 1 was traveling at approximately 50 mph eastbound on Lincoln Way East (US 30), Green Township, Franklin County. Unit 2 was directly behind Unit 3 at a complete stop in front of steady red traffic control signal at its intersection with Anthony Hwy (SR 997). Unit 1 was utilizing their GPS (no hands) and did not see Unit 2 or 3 prior to initial impact. Unit 1 struck Unit 2 at its 6 o'clock position and Unit 2 struck Unit 3 at its 6 o'clock position. Unit 1 and 2 were disabled on the travel lane. Unit 3's final rest was on the shoulder off of the travel lane. Unit 2 was towed from the scene with significant damage to it's 6 o'clock and 12 o'clock position by Abe's Towing. The operator and the passenger of Unit 2 were transported from scene to Chambersburg Hospital for further medical treatment with suspected minor injuries. Assisted on scene by Fayetteville EMS and Fire

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Department.

This crash occurred as Unit 1 was traveling East on Hager Road, Peters Township, Franklin County. Unit 1 failed to yield at a properly posted stop sign. Unit 2 was traveling North on Warm Spring Road, Peters Township, Franklin County. Unit 1 proceeded into the intersection while Unit 2 was approaching. Subsequently when Unit 2 crested the hill Unit 1 struck Unit 2 at the 1 O'clock position with Unit 2's 11 O'clock position (initial impact). Operator 1 came to controlled stop in a gravel lot near the crash site. Unit 2 became disabled in the field west of the crash site. Unit 2 was towed by Daves Truck repair towing. All involved Operators reported no injuries. Driver exchange reports were provided to all Operators.

Crash Synopsis:

This crash occurred at the intersection of John Wayne Dr and Buchanan Tr E, Antrim TWP. Franklin County, PA. Dispatch told me Unit 1 backed into Unit 2. At the same time, they were stopped on Buchanan Tr E. While en route, I was informed that Unit 2 was following Unit 1 onto I-81 N. Unit 2 followed Unit 1 to MM 14, where Unit 2 got Operator 1's attention. I arrived at MM 14 at approximately 1845 hours. On scene, I interviewed Operator 2. Operator 2 related that he was stopped behind Unit 1 on Buchanan Tr E when Unit 1 backed into his vehicle. I assessed the damage to Unit 2 and saw no damage to the vehicle. I asked Operator 2 to point



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out the damage to the vehicle and still saw no damage. I informed Operator 2 that, without visible damage, I had no physical evidence that a crash occurred. I asked both Operator 1 and 2 to exchange info. Both Unit 1 and 2 had no damage and were able to drive from the scene. Without visible damage to either vehicle, I recommend closing this crash due to the lack of evidence.
