Crash Synopsis:

This crash occurred as Unit 1 was traveling westbound on Interstate 80 in the lefthand lane of travel. Unit 2 was traveling behind Unit 1. Unit 1 was traveling at a low rate of speed without its hazard lights on. Unit 2 slowed down behind Unit 1. Unit 1 then suddenly slowed down again while turning its turn signal on to go into the righthand lane of travel. Unit 2 attempted to avoid Unit 1 by traveling off the southern edge of the roadway. Unit 2 struck Unit 1 on the rear of the vehicle causing it to turn and face in a southern direction. Both Unit 1 and Unit 2 struck the guardrail located off the southern side of the roadway before coming to final rest against the guard rail.

This crash occurred as Unit 1 was traveling eastbound on Interstate 80. Unit 1 was traveling in the righthand lane of travel and entered into the lefthand lane of travel. Unit 1 subsequently exited the northern side of the roadway and struck a guardrail on the front driver's side corner of the vehicle. Unit 1 then traveled across the roadway while spinning approximately 180 degrees and struck another guardrail located off the southern edge of the roadway. Unit 1 then traveled across the roadway again and spun around until it came to final rest off the northern side of the roadway and was facing in a western direction of travel.

Crash Synopsis:

Crash Synopsis:

This two-vehicle crash occurred as Unit #1 and Unit #2 were traveling northbound on Walton Street near Hudson Street in Decatur Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania. Unit #1 was traveling in the left passing lane of Walton Street and failed to observe Unit #2 traveling in the adjacent lane. Unit #1 then attempted to merge into the adjacent lane and struck Unit #2 at the 9 o'clock position. After impact Unit # 1 pushed Unit #2 into the guide rail before coming to a controlled stop. Both Unit #1 and Unit #2 were able to pull off the roadway.

No injuries were reported.

No airbag deployment was observed in Unit # 1 or Unit # 2. All operators were determined to be wearing lap

Crash Synopsis:

This 3-vehicle crash occurred as unit #1, unit #2, and unit#3 were all traveling west on SR 322, Decatur Twp., Clearfield Co. Unit #2 and unit #3 were stopped in a line of traffic due to construction on the roadway. For unknown reasons unit #1 did not stop and impacted the rear of unit #2 at a high rate of speed, pushing unit #2 into the rear of unit #3. Unit #1 came to final uncontrolled rest on the north berm of the roadway, facing west. Unit #2 came to final uncontrolled rest on the south berm of the roadway, facing south-west. Unit #3 came to final uncontrolled rest in a grassy area approximately 40 feet from the north berm of the roadway facing north-west.
