This crash occurred as Unit 1 was traveling northbound on State Route 53 (Morrisdale Allport Hwy) south of Trolley Street, Morris Township, Clearfield County ,PA.

Operator 1 was negotiating a left hand curve in the road, when for unknown reasons, Operator 1 failed to negotiate the left hand curve and left the road. Unit 1 continued straight off the road prior to striking a tree head on. Operator 1 was ejected from the motorcycle.

Operator 1 was wearing a helmet.

Operator 1 sustained fatal injuries as a result of the crash and was pronounced deceased at the scene.
