Crash Synopsis:

This crash occurred as UNIT 2 and UNIT 3 were stopped within the right lane of travel of I-80 East at 96.6 MM of a construction back log. UNIT 1 was traveling East within the right lane of travel when a tractor trailer he was following merged into the left lane. OPER 1 then observed traffic to be stopped and attempted to stop abruptly but ultimately impacted UNIT 2, this caused UNIT 2 to impact UNIT 3. OPER 2 sustained minor injury and was transported from the scene by EMS. Assisted at the scene by DuBois Fire Dept. and DuSan EMS.
